Years of work and worry had left their mark behind.*

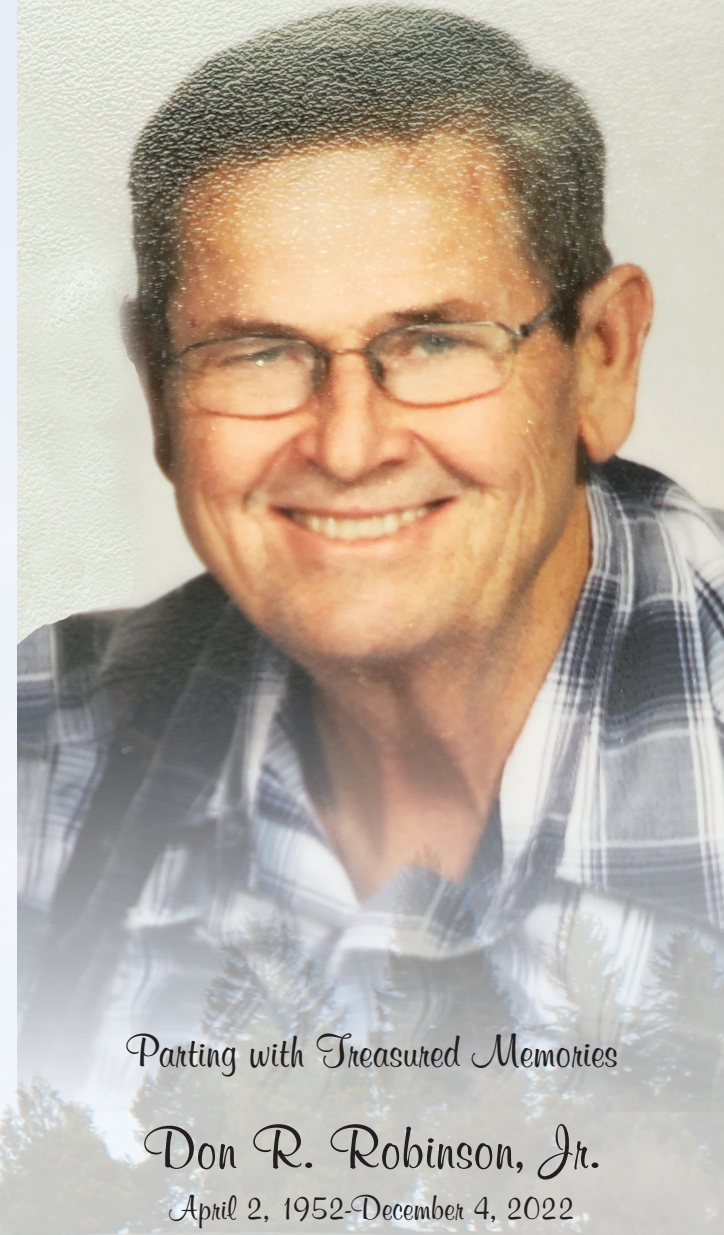
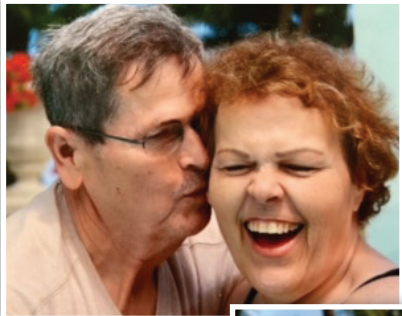
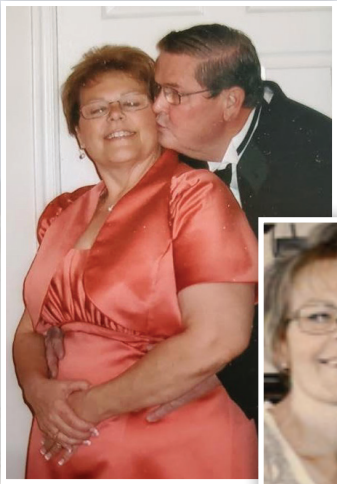
*I remember Daddy's hands
