

"Money makes the world go round..."

Well of course, we know that quote isn't true, but used well, money can make a positive difference to people's lives. As well as the World Mission Team and individual gifts from ABC, the Response Hub has been given grant funding from Trafford Housing Trust. So far, using the Winter Personal Support Fund (THT funding) we have been able to support 12 people, helping them with fuel costs, purchasing furniture and white goods, supplying supermarket vouchers and vouchers for clothing. We've been working closely with CAP, making sure we help the people that need it most.
