Clinton Dee Blaylock, born in El Paso, Texas, on August 17, 1945, to Odis and Mary Greer Blaylock, bid farewell to this world on March 11, 2024, in McDade, Texas, He was a devoted husband, a loving father, and a cherished friend to many. Raised in Abilene, Texas, Clinton attended Cooper High School and Cisco Junior College, His thirst for knowledge led him to proudly serve his country in the U.S. Navy. Throughout his 20 years in the military, Clinton traveled to various bases worldwide, earning the rank of Chief Petty Officer.
