RYAN CUSKELLY WINS CHICAGO OPEN

Australia's Ryan Cuskelly has claimed the Chicago Open for the second time in his career (also won in 2014), defeating Mexico's Cesar Salazar 11-5, 11-6, 11-3 in the final.

The tournament top seed didn't drop a game all tournament and credited Rod Martin for a different focus and for getting his game back on track.

"I started the season pretty slowly, so I just wanted to get back to playing some good squash again and I proved that this week winning most of the matches three-love which is good," Cuskelly said.

Salazar had a tough semi-final match-up against his brother, and Cuskelly said he knew he needed to capitalise early.

"He had a brutal game with his brother and I knew he'd be a little bit tired.

"I just tried to make the game as hard as I could at the start and unfortunately he was sort of on one leg.

"I'm happy with my week, I just wanted to play some good squash."

SARAH FITZ-GERALD RE-ELECTED AS WSF VICE-PRESIDENT

Australia's five-time World Champion Sarah Fitz-Gerald has been returned unopposed as Vice President of the World Squash Federation.

Fitz-Gerald was originally elected to the role in 2016 and will serve a second term in the role after holding her spot at the WSF AGM held in Cairo, Egypt.

Squash Australia CEO Richard Vaughan says it's great to have such a high profile Australian as part of the WSF panel.

"We see Sarah's appointment, along with a number of individuals on key commissions, as a way we can continue to both help guide the sport in the right Olympic direction and ensure Australia has a key position in that progress."

THE OLYMPIC PUSH

The World Squash Federation (WSF) has made clear its desire to join the Olympic programme. So have all leading world squash stars including Nicol David, the eight-time women's world champion, who has repeatedly said that she would swap all her world titles for an Olympic gold medal. The WSF, however, is short of funds and have turned to member associations to raise the money needed to drive the Olympic bid for Paris 2024.
