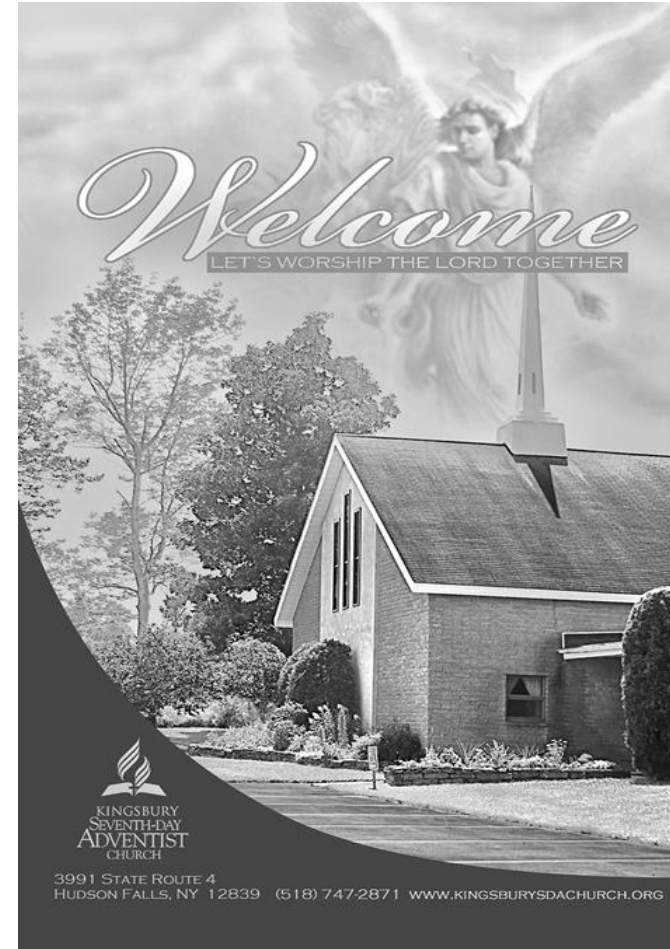

IN GOD’S WAITING ROOM

Wait and hope for and expect the Lord; be brave and of good courage and let your heart be stout and enduring. Yes, wait for and hope for and expect the Lord. Psalm 27:14 AMPC

Although God may ask us to be still as far as trying to change our circumstances is concerned, He is not asking us to do nothing. He wants us to have an attitude of expectancy regarding what He is doing, and He wants us to be hopeful and expect Him to do a marvelous work in our lives.
