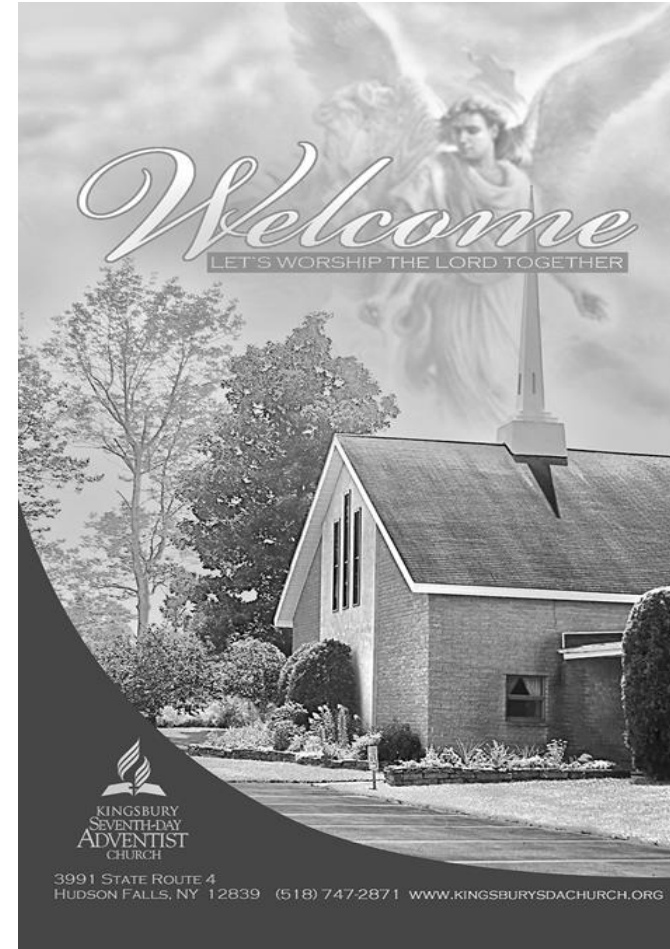

Trusting God To Change People

Learn to value people where they are, not where you would like them to be.

Pray with humility. Praying for others to change must be done with all humility, or we may fall into the same trap we think others are in.

“Father, I am asking that you change _____
If they truly need to change. If they don't, then change my heart and let me see my own error in thinking they do. I also ask that you change me in any way I need to change. Amen.”

The Power of Mercy. We need no other reason to show mercy to others than the fact that God has and does show us mercy. And He expects us to give to others what He generously gives to us. He forgives us and expects us to forgive. He loves us unconditionally and expects us to love others in the same way, and He gives us mercy for our failures and expects us to give mercy to others. God doesn't expect us to give what we don't have, so He equips us with every good thing that we need so we might be able to enjoy our lives and represent Him well.

When people in your life are not living the way they should and their behavior is hurting you or other people, be sure to pray diligently for them. Pray that they will listen to God before it is too late. That kind of merciful attitude is much better than a judgmental one!

Let's be sure that we remain faithful to all that God has asked of us. Let us be pliable and moldable in His hands and invite Him to make us vessels fit for His use.
