STORM DAMAGE - APPEAL FROM ELDER LESLIE LOUIS: Several of our churches were damaged in Hurricane Florence - Wilmington, New Bern Spanish, Jacksonville and others. Each of the churches has flood and storm insurance coverage, however, the deductible for wind damage is \$5,000 and for flood damage is \$25,000. This is an enormous hurdle for churches that are already struggling. We will be calling for a Conference-wide offering to help these hurting churches. Watch for details.

BBC - BUCKET BRIGADE CAMPAIGN / DISASTER RESPONSE: The BBC is an initiative to provide basic cleaning supplies to residents in the Carolinas and beyond, who suffered devastation from Hurricanes Florence and Michael. The contents for each bucket will cost approximately \$40. Our church will obtain 20 buckets and the Pathfinder Club will do the purchases, fill the buckets, and deliver them to the control site.
