### **O My Father**

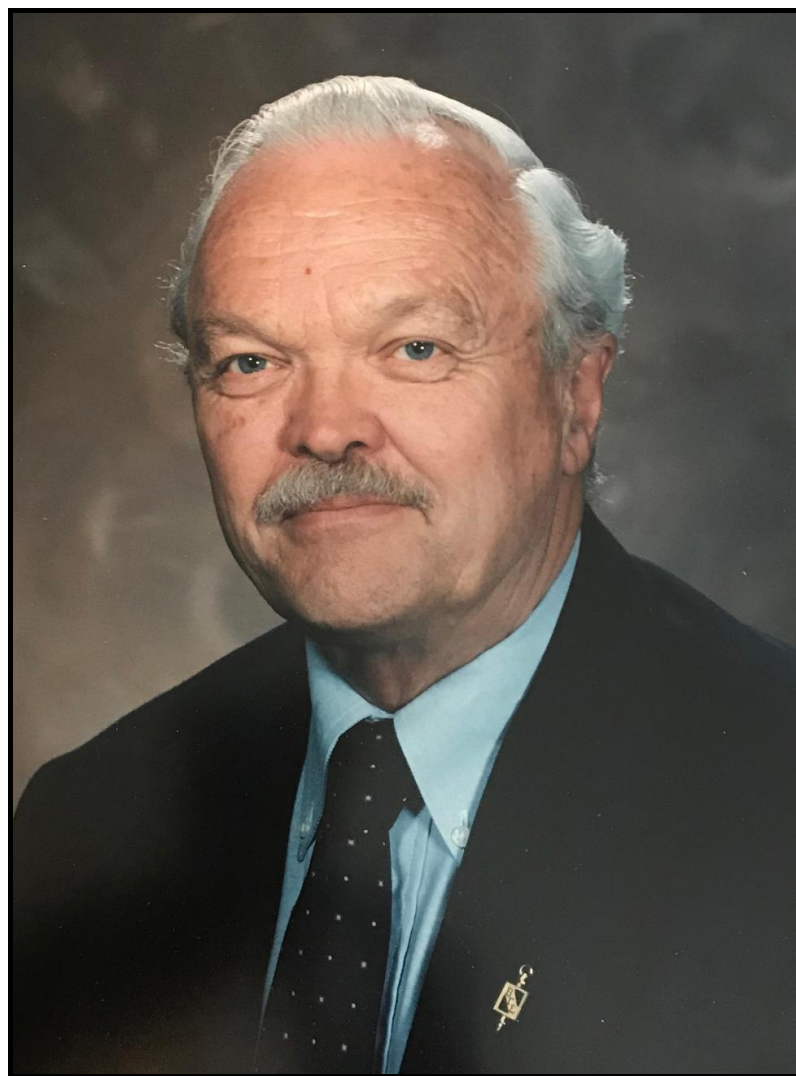
*O my Father, thou that dwellest
