## DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS OF THE AVON PARK SDA CHURCH

We received your financial assistance through the Inter-American Division. Thank you very much for remembering us here in Puerto Rico. The damage caused by Hurricane Maria was very big. Homes, roads, electricity and many other things were destroyed! But the biggest damage that has traumatized our people, especially among poor families, was that caused to our children. Your offering was dedicated exclusively to give hope to Puerto Rican children. We are sending you information on three groups that were helped with your offering.

The first one was in the picturesque city of Las Marias, the Brayon Sector, where there is a community school with 92 students, half of them are special education children of parents who work in agriculture. We bought sneakers, shoes and boots. Also, pizza and juice. It was an extraordinary day!

The second group was in the community of Furnias, also in Las Marias. There are four children that are taken care of by their dad. Their mother abandoned them over five years. They lost the roof of their house, their food, they lost everything. ADRA replaced their roof and thanks to your offering we bought them clothes. Two church members took them shopping so they could have the satisfaction of picking their own clothes, something they had not experienced before. Brothers & sisters, thank you and the children of this church for the initiative to help the children of Puerto Rico.

The last group we helped with your offerings was a lady by the name of Yesenia in Adjuntas, Puerto Rico. She is the mother of three children ages 12, 11 and 9. They had received water, food, toys and other aids but that does not heal the emotions of these children. Three days after the hurricane, they returned from the shelter to see their house, but the house was not there, the hurricane devastated it completely. They are traumatized and wandering from family to family. I want to tell you that we have already started the construction of a new house so that they and their mother can soon enjoy it.

I ask you not to forget these children of the Lord. I ask you to help us finish their new house and stabilize them. Thanks for your help, for making our children happy and I invite you to finish what we have started together. God bless the children and brethren of the Avon Park Seventh-day Adventist Church for having a passion to serve. *Pastor José Alberto Rodríguez, Puerto Rican Union President*
