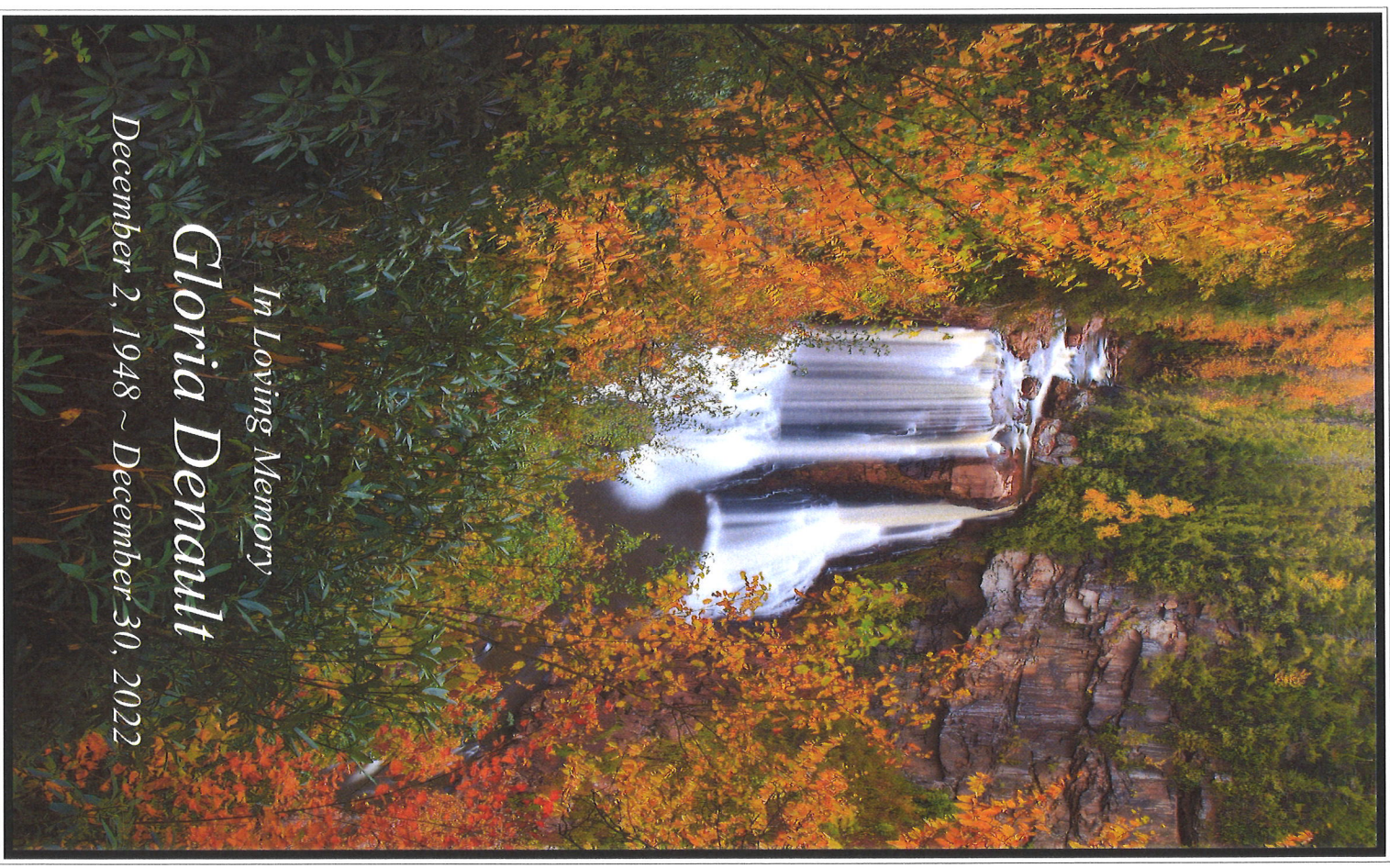


## *A Mom Is...*
