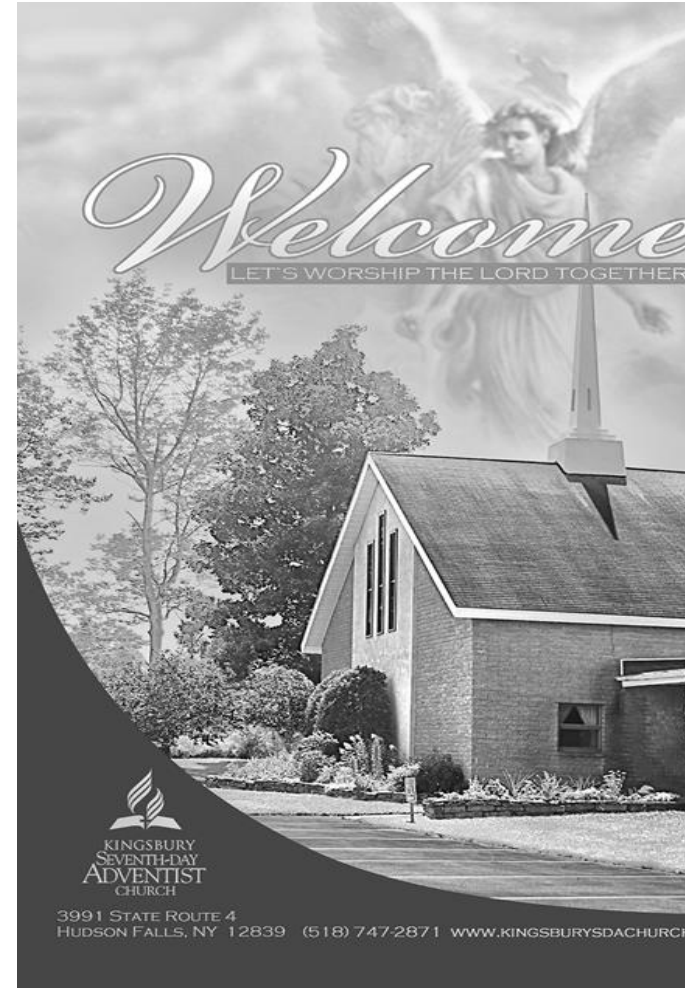

How to Hear the Voice of God
The Voice of Gladness ...Nonconformity

“Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.”

This is one of the hardest commands in Scripture because our culture is so good at conditioning us according to its values. We can be exposed to thousands of advertising messages every day. It doesn't seem like it, does it? That is how good our culture is at it. *And we have to fight it. Not many people sell their souls to the devil, but many of us sell our souls to the culture.*

Instead of defining success for ourselves, we let the culture define it for us. Instead of daring to be different, we conform to the pattern of this world. Why? We let our culture have the loudest voice.

We worry way too much about what people think, which is evidence that we don't worry enough about what God thinks. It's the fear of people that keeps us from hearing and heeding the voice of God.

The Bible calls us “a peculiar people.” So why are we trying to be normal? If uniqueness is God gift to us, then individuation is our gift back to Him. And it starts with hearing and heeding the voice of desire. **And when God's voice is the loudest voice in our lives, we can dare to be different.**
