

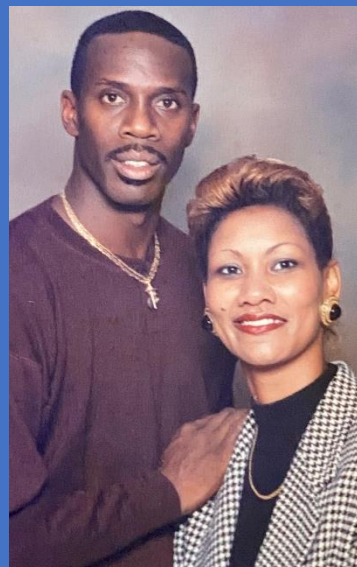
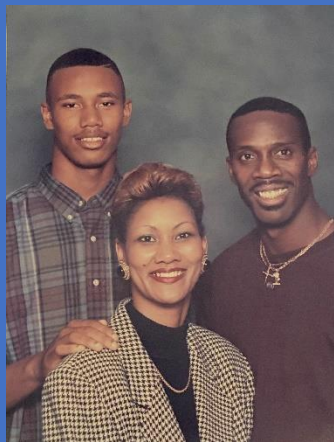


To David, aka "Pinky"
