Dennis J. "Whitey" Schiele, 67 of Devils Lake, ND passed away on Saturday, December 30, 2023, at St. Mary's

Dennis Jack Schiele was born on September 24, 1956, to Jack and Katherine (Bachmeier) Schiele in Devils Lake, ND. He was raised on a family farm in Noonan Township. He attended Crary Public School from Kindergarten until

twelfth grade, graduating with the class of 1974.
