This year this bulletin space will be filled with materials drawn from a book written by Elmer Towns, Dean Emeritus of the School of Religion and Theological Seminary at Liberty University in Lynchburg, VA. It is entitled "I Am Jesus: Let's Change the World."

"You as a pure bride to one husband—Christ." (2 Corinthians 11:2, NLT)

The church is pictured as My bride. A bride is beautiful to the groom; all those who are saved are beautiful to Me because I first loved them. Just as a bride gives herself to her husband, so to you must give yourself to Me. You will do that because you love Me. It will be easy to love Me when you realize how much I love you.
