

<u>Children's quiet activity bags</u> are available in a basket outside the double doors of the sanctuary. Feel free to borrow a bag per child each Sabbath.

<u>Nursing Room</u> for mothers to feed and change their babies. To give these babies and mothers quiet privacy, no men are allowed. Changing tables are also available in the men's restroom.

<u>Training Chapel</u> is an option for parents with fussy children during church, and is located in the Adult I classroom. Quiet books/toys are available at the front of this area. Parents appreciate having the service live streamed into this room.
