Debt Reduction Campaign In addition to faithfully supporting our monthly loan payments of \$6.500/month, our end-of-year Debt Reduction Campaigns during the past three years have enabled us to reduce our loan principal balance by \$374,085! As a result, our current loan balance is now down to \$378,065. Loan payoff will take us 5 years 7 months of monthly payments—unless we are able once again this year to reduce the loan principle balance which not only reduces the time to loan payoff, but also saves us the interest included in our monthly payments. Last year, our Debt Reduction effort raised \$57,739. A Debt Reduction Goal of \$60,000 this year would reduce our time to loan payoff by a whole year! Shall we go for it?

In early 2016, we planned to borrow \$942,000 and take 20 years to pay it off. We ended up borrowing \$615,000, and here we are less than 3 years later within range of paying off our loan within the next 3-4 years. How's this for powerful evidence of God's abundant blessing for our building project!
