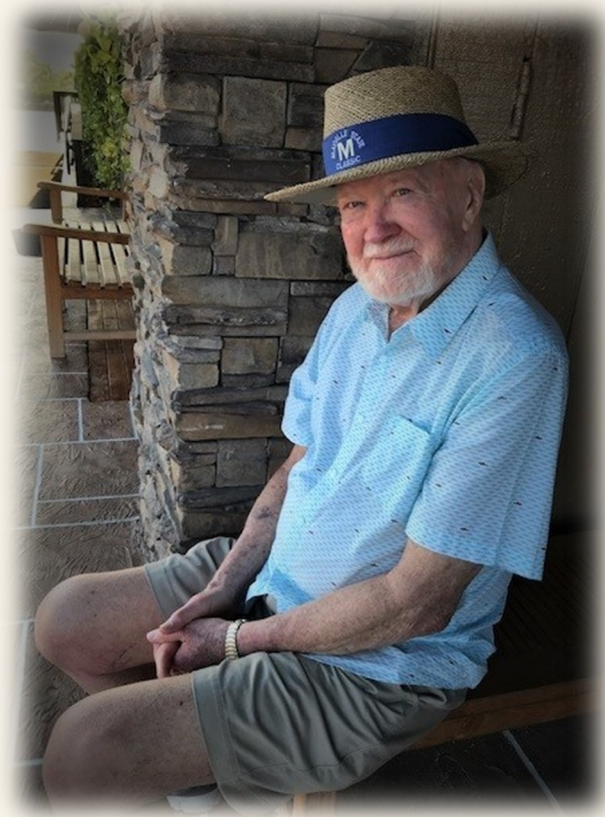
He is preceded in death by his parents Harry and Alpha Hultgren and 8 siblings.

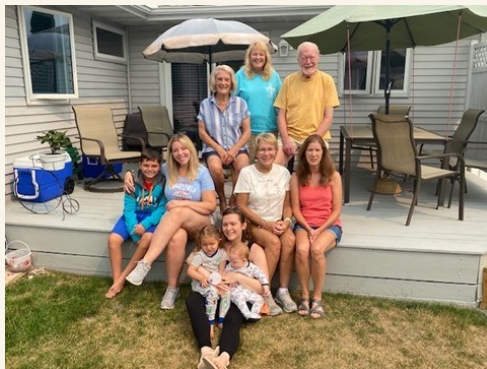


# **Delmoure H. Hultgren**
