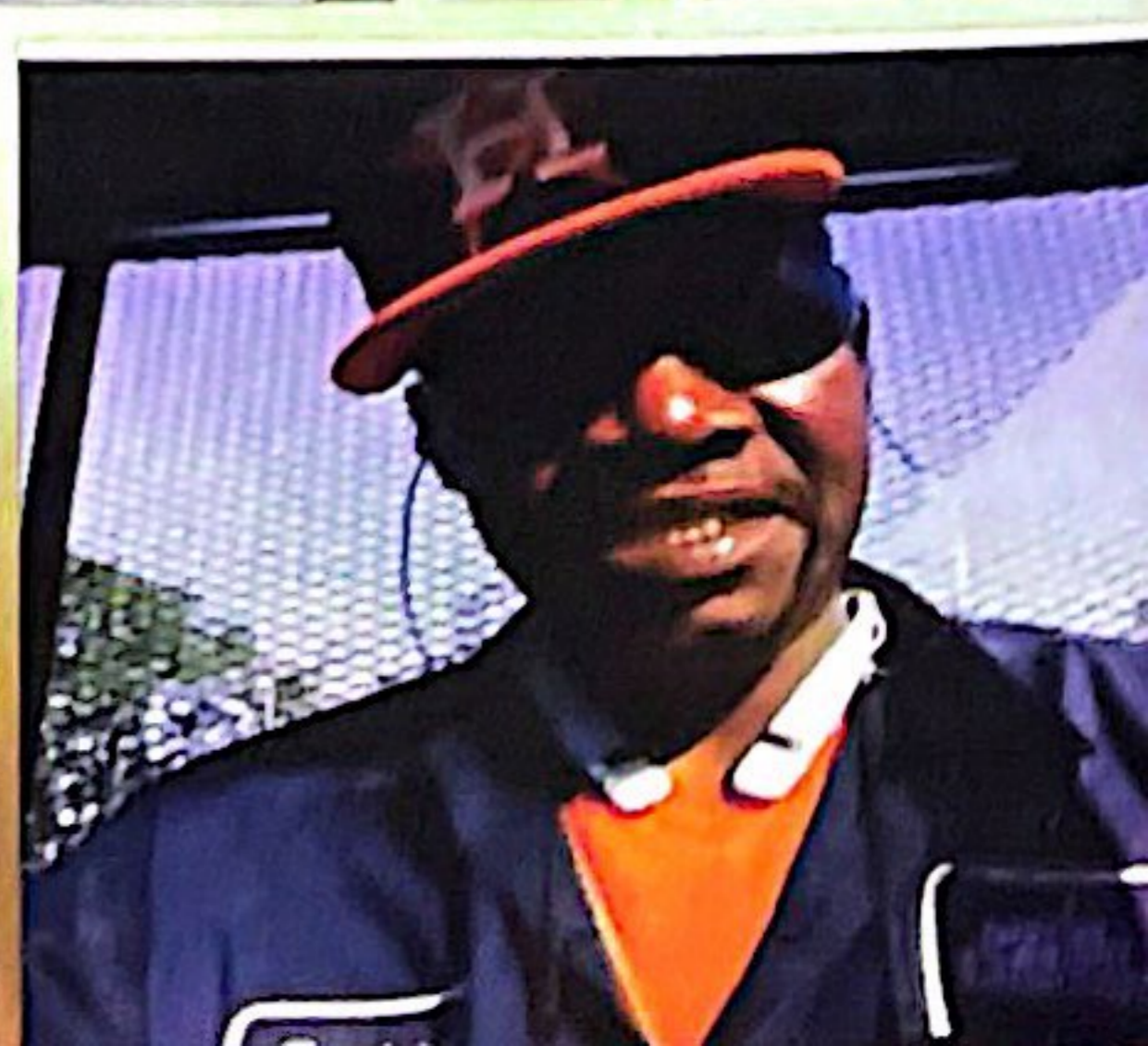
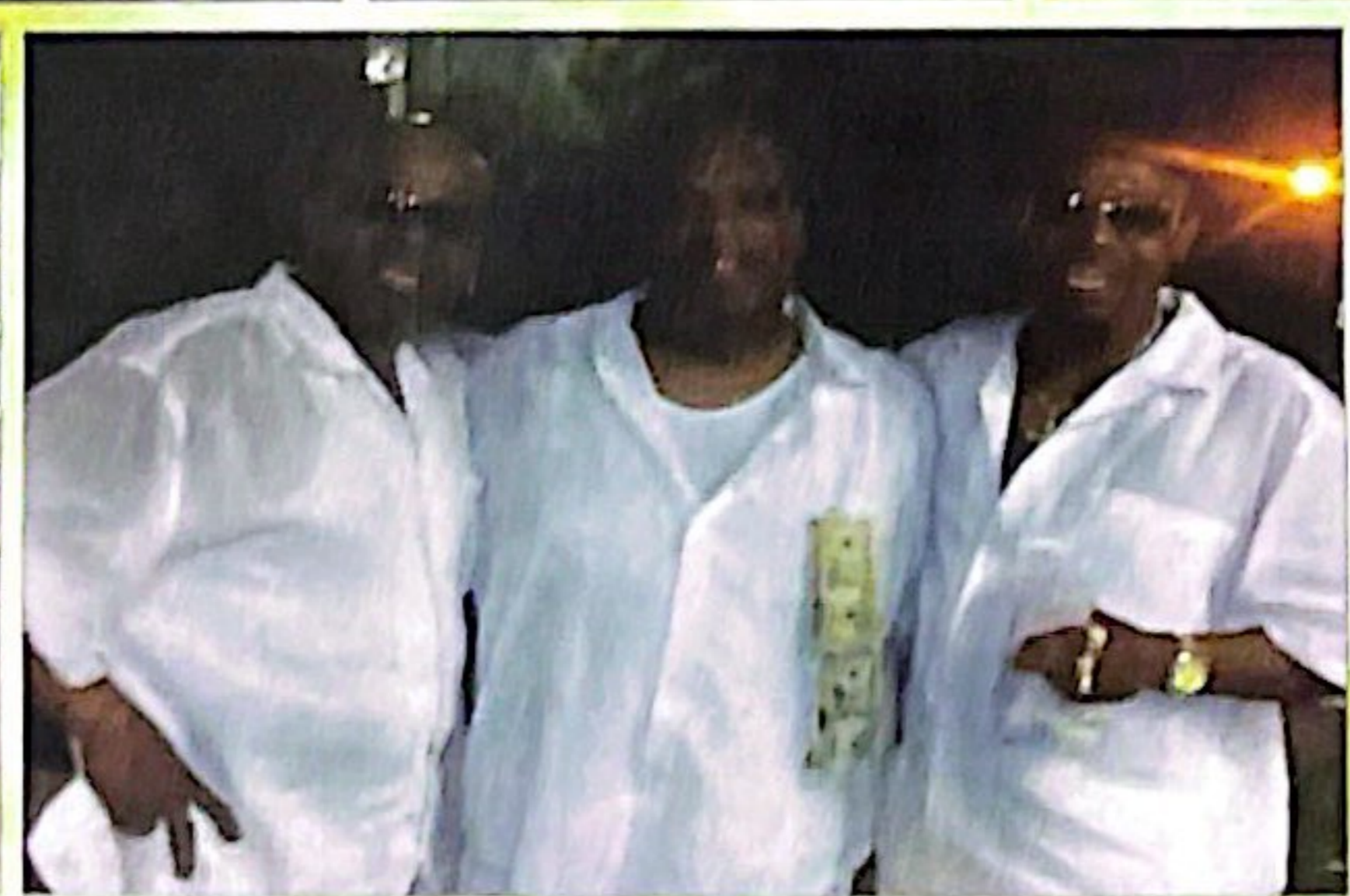
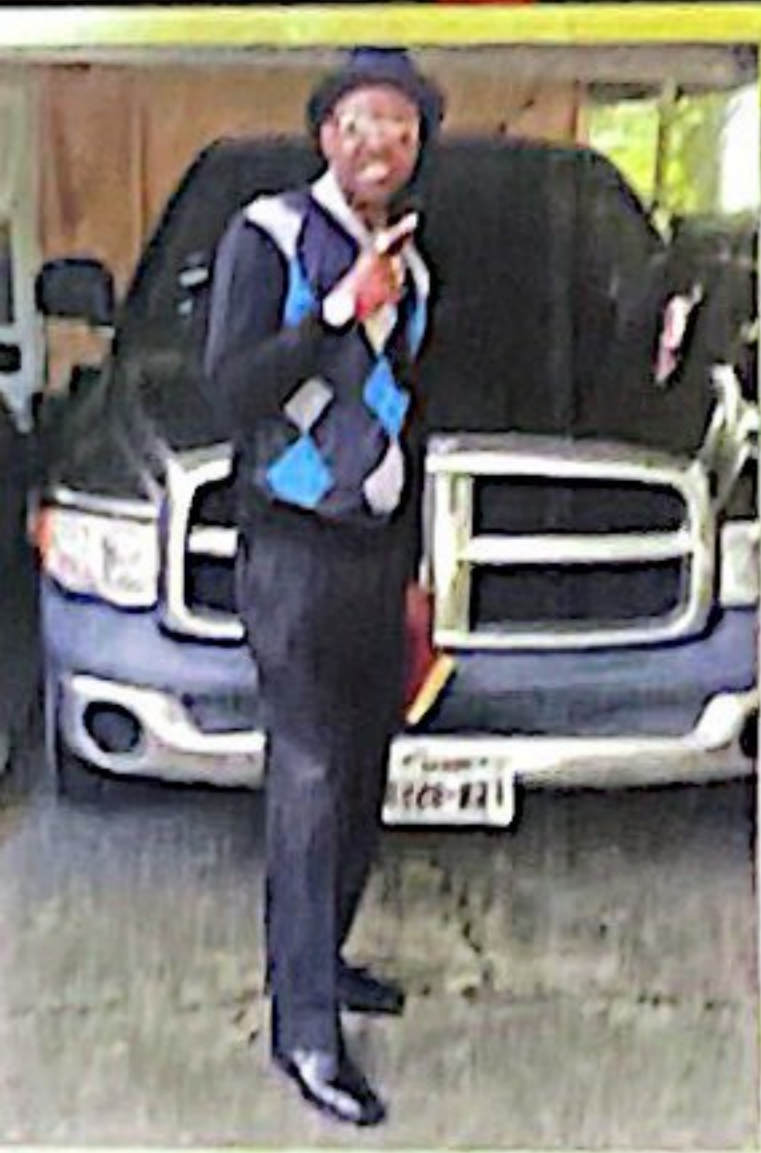
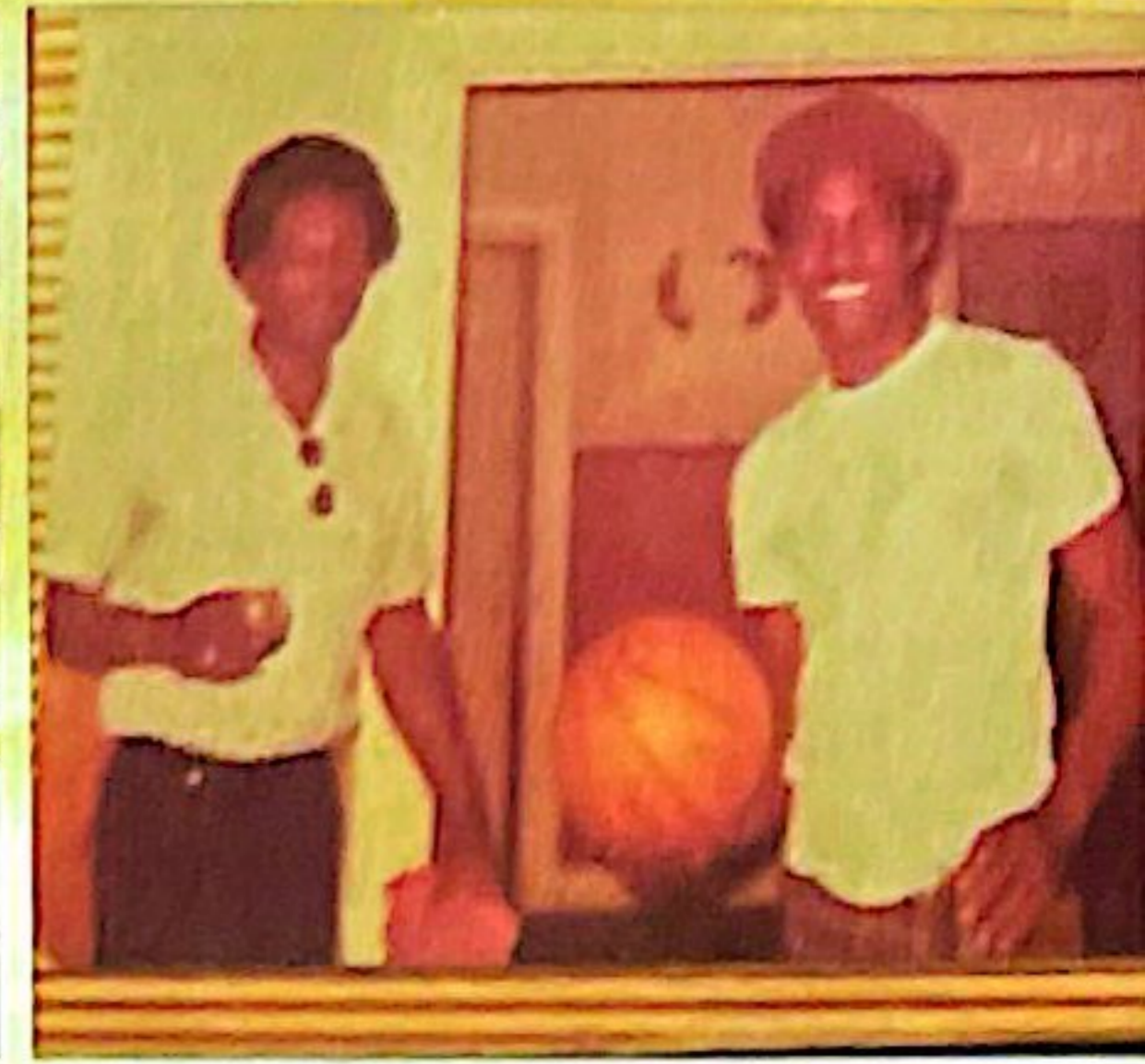
We are hurt and broken, we are angry and disappointed, because you were taken from us so soon, we are not ignorant, concerning you who are asleep.

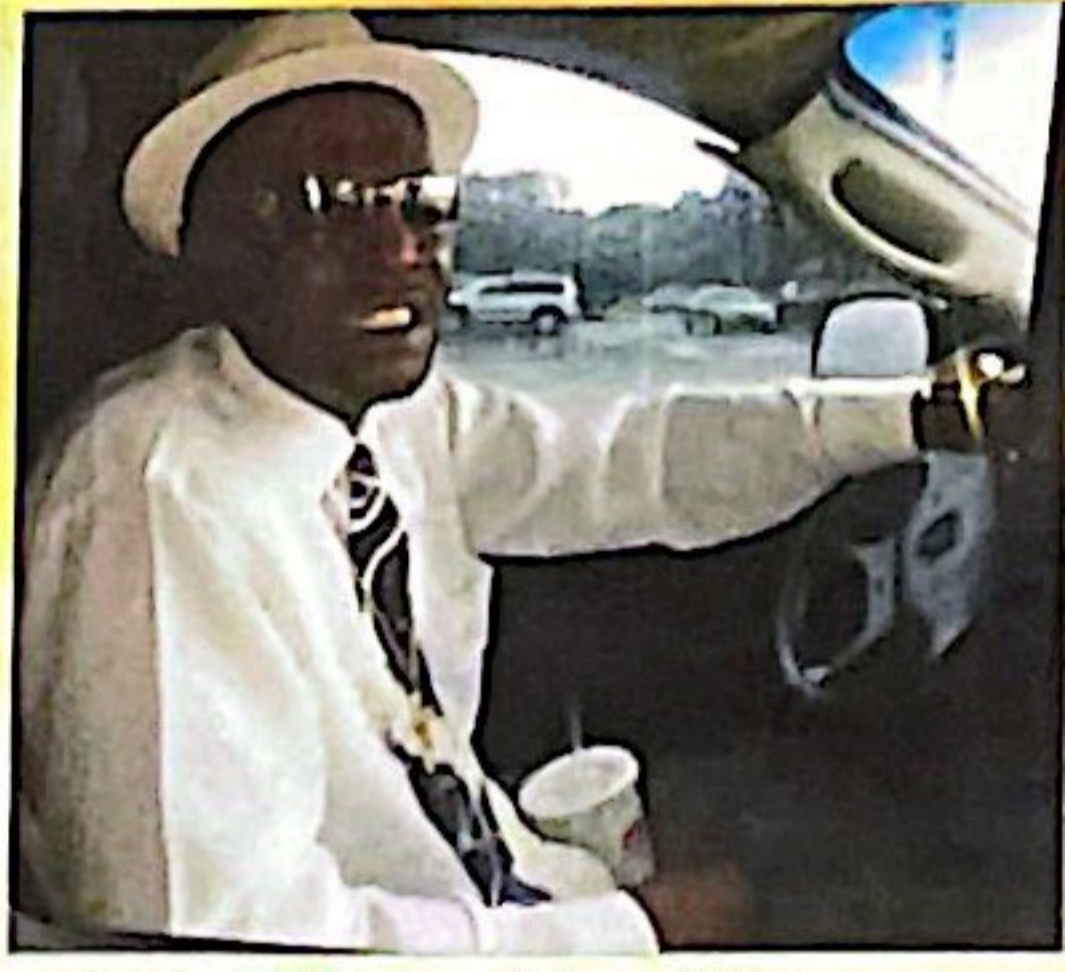
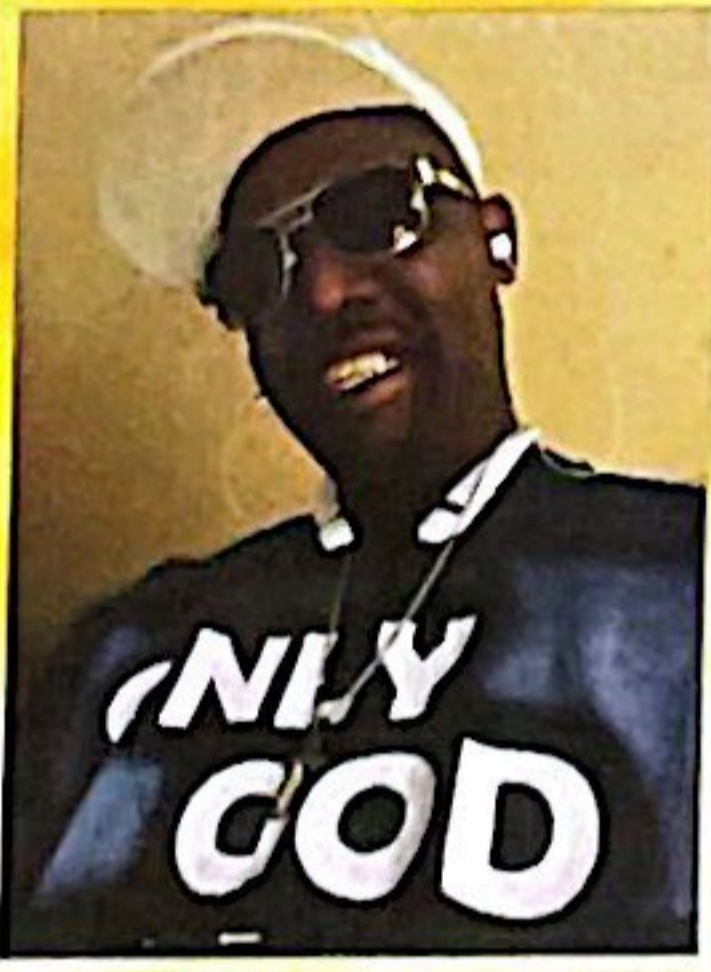
