Rev Alan writes...

Transforming Bolton Together in Jesus' Name On Wednesday, a group of nine of us from our PCC and fellowship leadership teams joined 45 leaders from churches of all denominations across Bolton for a leader's breakfast and retreat morning in the Chairman's Suite at BWFC stadium. It was organised by the Passion for Bolton church leaders' network, with the aim to support leaders, build unity, and create new opportunities for collaboration. It was a time of refreshment as we reflected and prayed together. We looked at Nehemiah's prayer for the restoration of Jerusalem in Neh 1:1-11 and drew parallels with Bolton as we considered how the church can play its part in helping our wonderful town to flourish and prosper.



Phil Mason, BWFC Club Chaplain and board member, finished the morning with the inspiring story of the founding of the Wanderers in 1874. Phil told us how the concern of Rev Joseph Farrall Wright of Christ Church in Deane for the needs of young people in the town, led to the formation of Christ Church FC which ultimately became BWFC – it's a story of how small beginnings led to a remarkable legacy!

It led me to reflect on our parish strapline to *Transform Bolton Together in Jesus' Name* and what this means in practice. I've a real sense of God working amongst us, to strengthen and build us up as his church, in readiness to play a bigger part across the town in the years to come. *Continued on page 2...* I believe that much of our current teaching through our sermon series', together with the improvements to our buildings and the strengthening of our leadership teams, are all stepping stones towards realising this bigger vision.

This Sunday marks the first of our annual meetings at Barrow Bridge Mission. These meetings provide a great opportunity to look back and give thanks for all that God has been doing. And I know Dan Caffrey, chair of Barrow Bridge fellowship, will be reflecting on the impact of 25 years of their extended mission building. It's also a time for us to pray and consider our vision for the future and the part we can all play in the growth and mission of our fellowships.
