 3. So long thy pow'r hath blest me, sure it still      Will lead me on

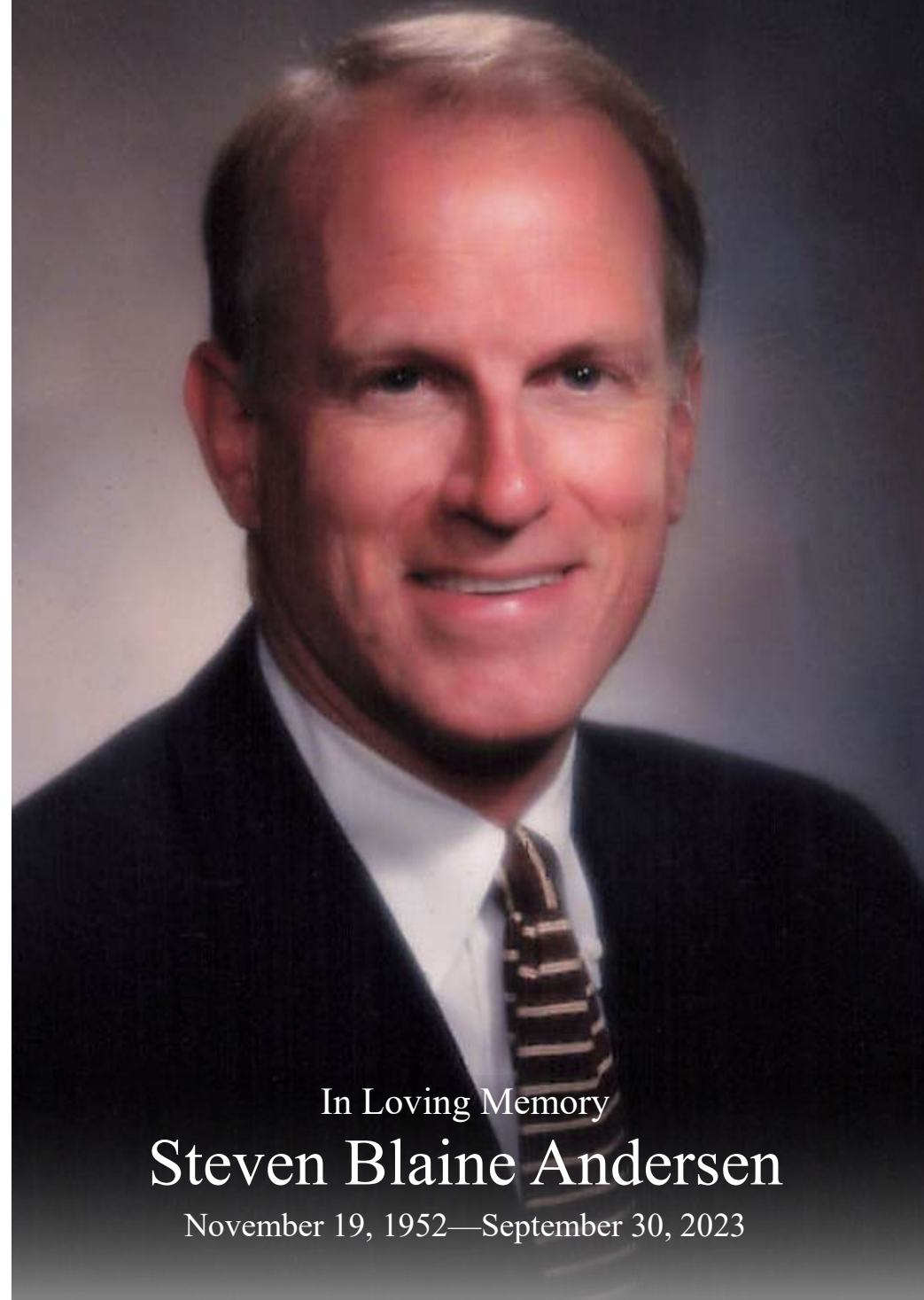
The night is dark, and I am far from home;      Lead thou me on!
