**Selling Community Services Building** - At our church board meeting last Tuesday evening, a vote was taken to sell the Community Service Center building and put the money realized by that sale into a restricted fund for a youth activities multipurpose building. Prior to this decision, two entities looked at the feasibility of using the building but neither felt they could ultimately make it work for them. North Valley considered an outreach there but found, as we did, that there was no one who was able to lead out and commit the time to run it successfully. Our Pathfinders and Adventurers clubs went as far as to obtain estimates to remodel and update the building for their possible use, but the \$40-\$60,000 price tag was deemed too steep for such an old building that even remodeled didn't meet all of their requirements. The Conference, as owner of the building, has been contacted and agreed that a recommendation by the board to sell will start the ball rolling. This recommendation has been made and will be presented at a church business meeting on February 26th during which time the entire congregation will vote on the issue. If the vote there is to sell, the recommendation from the church will go to the Board of Directors of the Montana Conference which is meeting on March 11th. At this point in time there is no timetable for the new building to be erected but as it is possible to move the project forward the congregation will be informed and involved in every phase. As with any new direction contemplated by a church family, your prayers concerning the project are solicited as a necessary part of the process. Thank you to each one of you in advance for your commitment to keep this sale and future use of the money gained from it consistently in your prayers.

**Debt Reduction Campaign** In addition to faithfully supporting our monthly loan payments of \$6,500/month, our end-of-year Debt Reduction Campaigns during the past three years have enabled us to reduce our loan principal balance by \$374,085! As a result, our current loan balance is now down to \$378,065. Loan payoff will take us 5 years 7 months of monthly payments— unless we are able once again this year to reduce the loan principle balance which not only reduces the time to loan payoff, but also saves us the interest included in our monthly payments. Last year, our Debt Reduction effort raised \$57,739. A Debt Reduction Goal of \$60,000 this year would reduce our time to loan payoff by a whole year! Shall we go for it?

**Goal: \$60,000 To date: \$44,590**

In early 2016, we planned to borrow \$942,000 and take 20 years to pay it off. We ended up borrowing \$615,000, and here we are less than 3 years later within range of paying off our loan within the next 3-4 years. We are so grateful to the Lord for blessing us as individuals and families so that we the church family could continue supporting our building project in this way. All the credit goes to Him!

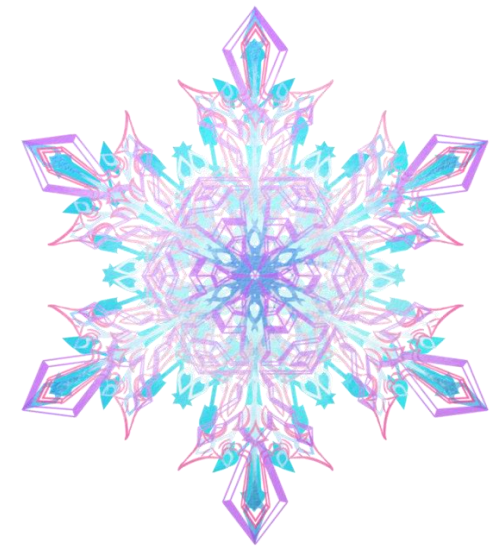
