Here am I, send me. Here am I, send me.

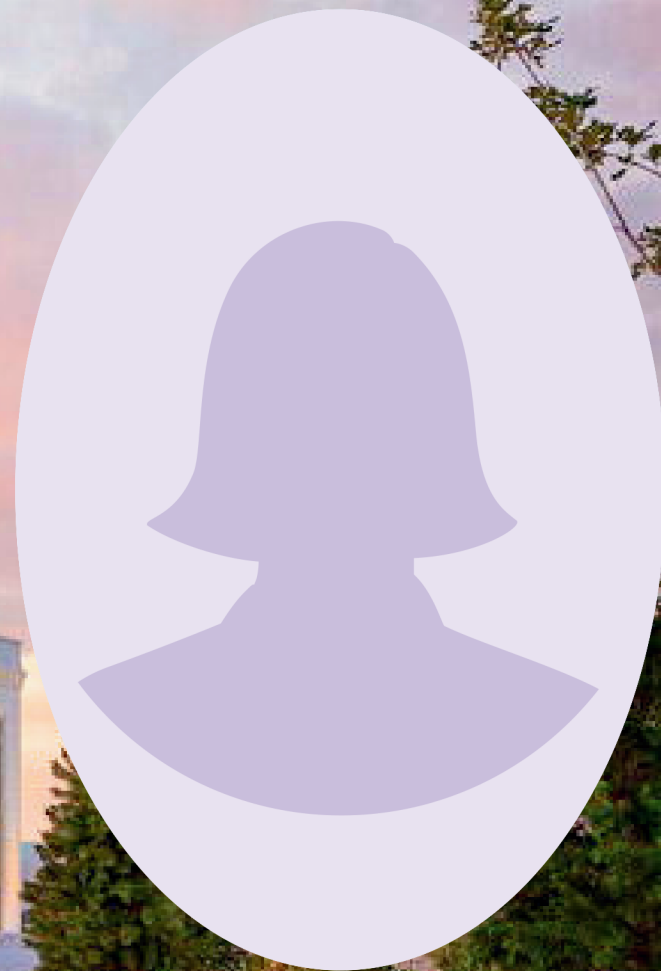
Whether foreign land or neighbors,
