THE LATEST . . .

1. The Dare to Care Camporee is going to be wheelchair accessible! Our camping grounds are hard and flat. Red Rocks can accommodate wheelchairs too! We will have handicap busses available for evening program shuttling. If there's any other way we can make your stay more comfortable, let us know!
2. Our evening programs will have headsets available that will translate the program into French, Spanish and possibly Russian!
3. At ASI's recent convention in Toronto, Canada, Dare to Care was donated \$3,000!

4. I just spent a weekend with Pathfinder leaders in British Columbia, Canada. Seven or eight of their clubs will be represented at the Camporee! Way to go!
5. Area Coordinators are more than welcome to join us in 1994. You can either sign up as individuals, sign up together and camp together, or sign up with a club and join them for the 5 days.
6. Monies left over at the end of the Dare to Care Camporee will be tithed 10 percent and the rest will go into a fund for the next Camporee. It is tentatively scheduled for 1999, unless the Lord comes. Are you a state that would like to host the next Camporee? Let us know!
7. Attention Pathfinders! Bring your Class A uniforms with you. Each day a different union or unions will parade down "main street" in Class A. There is no parading on Sabbath morning, but Class A is required for Sabbath School and Church.
8. September 13, 1993- Denver has had its first snowfall of the year! What should you expect in August of 1994? Rain, sun, hail, and yes . . . possibly, but not probably, SNOW! The average, maximum temperature in August is 84.9. The average minimum is 57.8 (both are based on Fahrenheit). It is sunny 72 percent of the time and the average rainfall for August is 1.39 inches (1993 Official Visitor's Guide, 7).
9. Do you know an Adventist musician, storyteller, pantomime, actor/actress or puppeteer that would like to perform at the Camporee? Tell them to send their cassette tapes, CDs, and video tapes to our Dare to Care Headquarters, no later than April 15, 1994.
10. Pathfinder Directors: Register yourselves and your Pathfinders as the registration fee

comes in to reserve yourselves a spot. We do not require that you register the entire club at once.

11. You will receive your 1994 Dare to Care four inch embroidery patch upon arrival at the Camporee once your ticket is presented.

12. Are you driving to the Camporee and looking for places to stay at little or NO COST to your Pathfinders? Group Publishing has a booklet entitled, Youth Group Travel Directory, that lists nearly two hundred places (mostly churches, all Christian), that will accommodate youth groups for a small fee or NOTHING! 13. You can come in to Bandimere Campgrounds and begin setting up at 12:00 Noon on Monday, August the first. No one will be allowed on the grounds prior to that time.

*** Have you seen Red Rocks Amphitheater in your brochure? The rock on the left is called "Ship Rock"; the one on the right is "Creation Rock".**

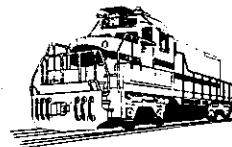
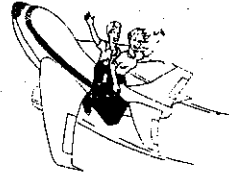

THE RUMOR MILL vs. THE REAL STORY

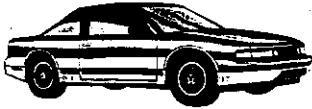
RUMOR: Pathfinders will be assigned by conference or unions as to which activities they go to during the day.
