As you walk on by

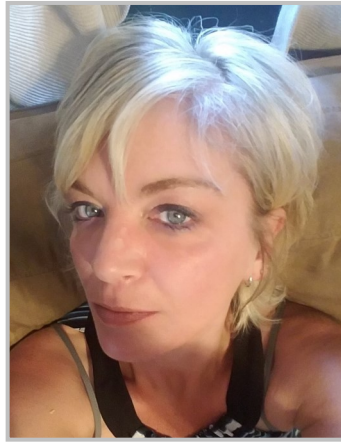


Peaceful Rest
