



It was June 16, 1972 in Denver, Colorado when Tyree LaVell Wilson was born to Lavernette Wilson and Darryl Andrews. Tyree attended Barrett Elementary school, Gove Junior High School, Bishop Machebeuf High School, and Metropolitan State University of Denver.
