- \* Effective Fall 2000, the grade of A+ has been discontinued for undergraduate students.
- \* Effective Fall 2004, designation of "Honors" will be replaced by "Dean's List" for each semester earned. Requirements for this distinction have not changed.
- \* Grades of W, WF, WP, AU, NG, IP, M, Y are not computed into the totals. A 'D' grade is not applicable toward graduate degree. A 'P' grade counts for earned credit only. RPT=Repeated Course, T= Transfer Credit, TP=Transfer Credit for a course taken elsewhere as Pass/Fail.
