

E-day Family Information

In the event the CCS closes school due to inclement weather or any other dangerous situation, we will call an "E-day". What is an E-day? It is simply an Educational Day held at home. It is a new solution to keeping our kids safe, while still meeting all the required school days. And, yes, it is very much a legal and accepted practice.

Families will be notified of E-days by Remind texts. (Please make sure the office has your most current contact information.) E-days are used for school closures and/or ski days where less than 50% (27 students) of our students attend.

Your student has a new page in the back of his/her take-home folder that contains a number of E-day Assignment Sheets. In the event an E-day is called, your child will need to complete one of these assignment sheets as follows:

- 1) Retrieve a page from the E-day Assignment Sheet section on the back of his/her folder or download a copy from our school website (link will be sent via Remind).
- 2) Select an activity under each category to do for the required time period.
- 3) Mark which activity was completed on the sheet.
- 4) When an activity has been completed in ALL of the categories, sign the bottom of the form.
- 5) Return the completed form to school on the first day school is back in session.
- 6) Assignments that are completed and signed by the adult will be listed in JupiterEd as Eday assignment within each subject area.
