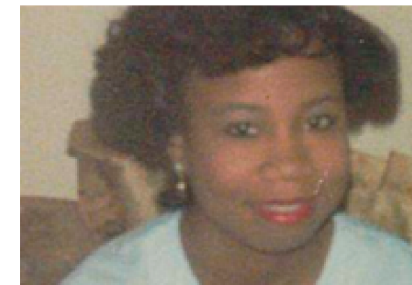
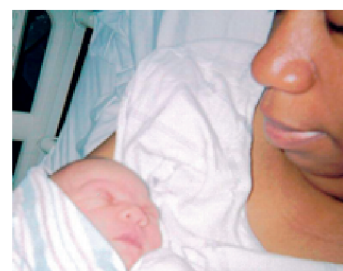
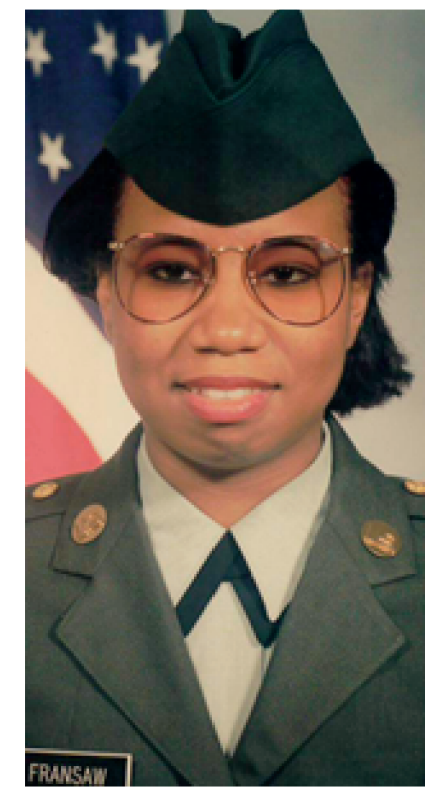
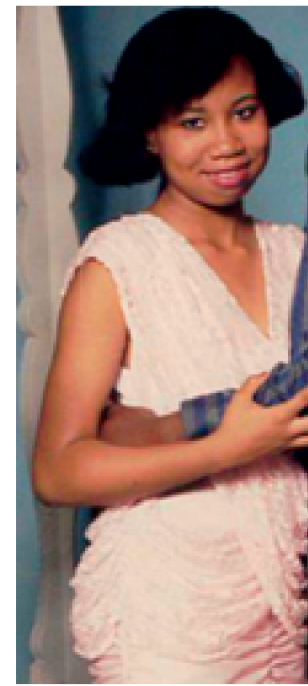
The time has come to say goodbye,

For we'll always keep you close in our hearts.

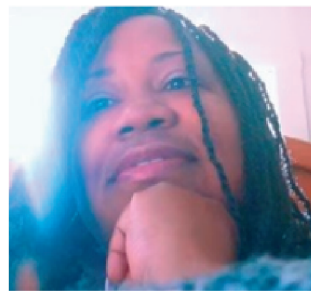
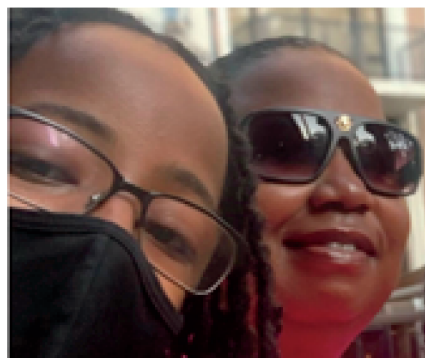
We've laughed, we've cried, we've shared our life,

Our bond will **never** be undone.

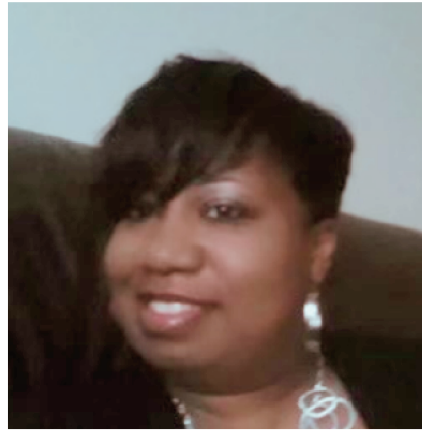




My Goodbye
