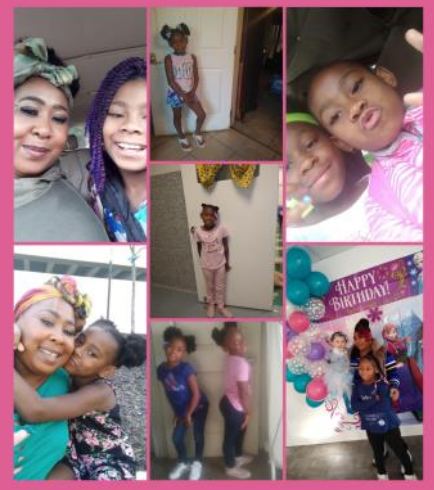

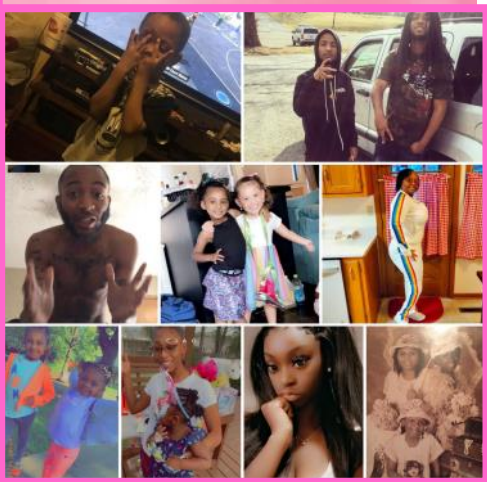


Though I am Gone

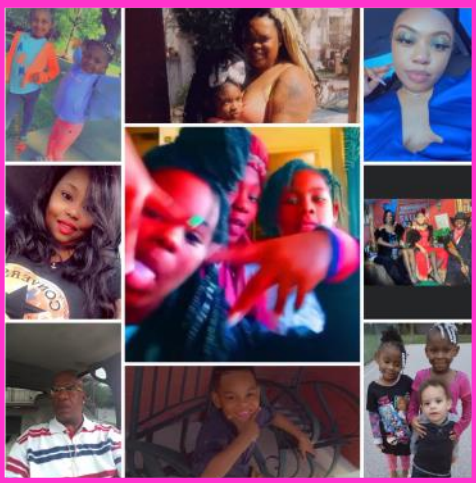

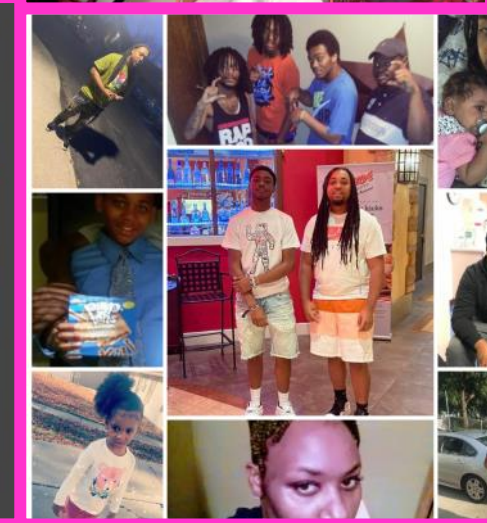
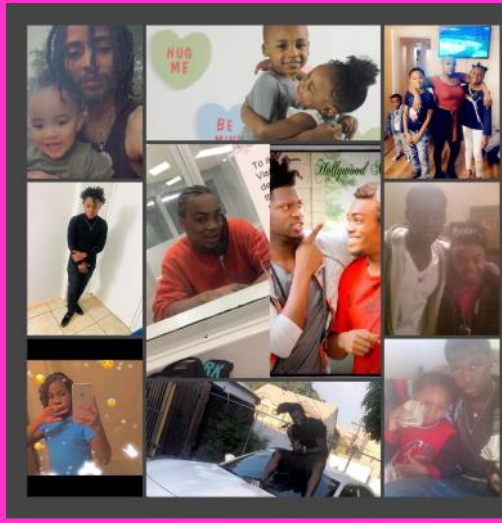
