She was baptized July 3, 1932, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Garfield, Minnesota by Reverend John F. Malkow. She was confirmed June 30, 1946, by Reverend K.S. Michelson at First Lutheran Church in New Rockford, North Dakota. Carol grew up and attended school in New Rockford, North Dakota, graduating from New Rockford High School in 1950. She attended St. Olaf College in Northfield, Minnesota from 1950-1954 receiving a degree in education. Carol taught Home Economics in Red Lake Falls, Sauk Centre and Alberta, MN from 1954-1961. Carol was united in marriage to Donald Linser on June 29, 1958, at St. John's Lutheran Church in Garfield, MN by Reverend L. Bursch. The couple made their home in Morris where they were blessed with three children Julie, Jay and Jon. Carol taught part time in Morris from 1964 until her retirement in 1991. Following their retirement, Carol and Don continued to live in Morris. Don passed away November 25, 2020. Carol moved to West Wind Village in 2021 where she continued to live until the time of her death.
