Trusting that You will make all things right

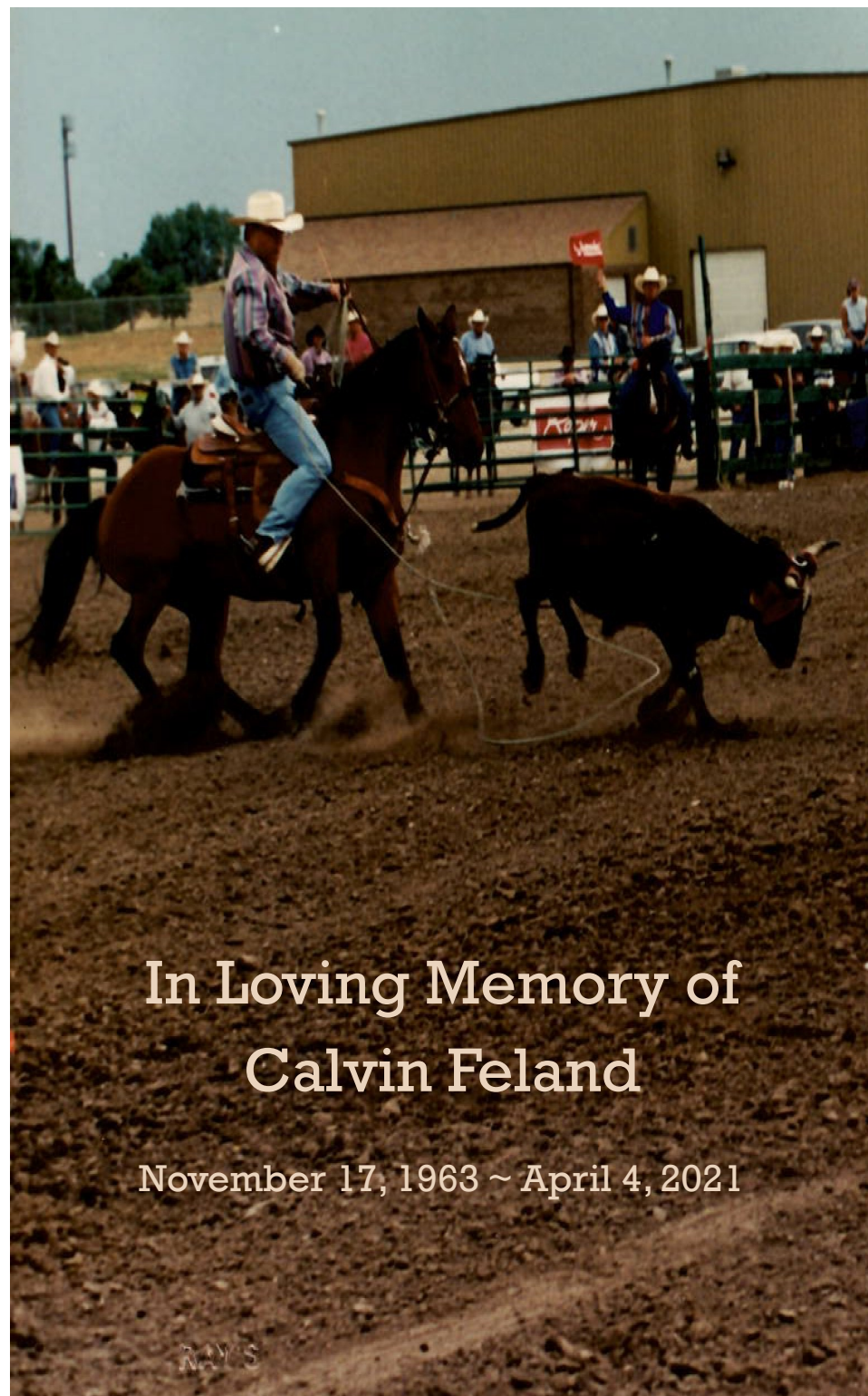
If I surrender to Your will;
