



Lillian Kary, 96, Bismarck, died September 3, 2024, at St. Vincent's Care Center, Bismarck.

Lillian was born August 21, 1928, in Morton County, the daughter of Matt and Rose (Schmidt) Barnhardt. She was raised and educated in the Crown Butte and Center areas. Lillian graduated from Mandan High School in 1947, and then attended Dickinson State College where she received her teacher's certification. On June 21, 1950, Lillian married Matt Kary at St. Vincent's Church in Crown Butte. Lillian worked as a clerk at JC Penney's and taught grades 1-8 in a one room school house in the Crown Butte area in the early 1950's. Lillian and Matt moved to Bismarck in 1955 with their two daughters. Lillian helped Matt with his Kirby vacuum cleaner business. Later she worked as a bookkeeper for Lindsay Water Softener. Lillian ended her working career as a concession station manager at the Bismarck Civic Center when she retired at age 82.
