We discussed revenue and outreach. We'll give \$100 to St. James Family Center and \$100 to American Friends, Epis-Jerusalem and \$250 to Food Bowl.

Business items: Jim bought a new computer to use for Chaplains and St. Mark's finance issues for \$256.00. St. Marks will reimburse him \$125.00.

We discussed Pancake Day. Mary discussed her work with the jail ministry.

Priest report: Lorraine went to the nursing home.
