RE: Master Guide Convention – March 8-10, 2019

Please be advised that the Master Guide Convention will take place at Camp Cedar Falls March 8-10, 2019. This Convention is for the continuing education of the Master Guides in our Conference and to be recognized as a Registered Master Guide and/or Authorized Master Guide with Youth Ministries Department of the So. California Conference. Please see enclosed the Registration Form and the Master Guide Contact Information Form that **is DUE** at our office on or before **Monday, March 4.**

For your clarification:

1. Registered Master Guide List: *This list indicates individuals who have attended Master Guide Conventions who can teach, mentor, and direct Master Guide Candidates working on their M.G. Requirements (Yellow Sheet). These individuals can only SIGN-OFF on a line item of the Requirement Sheet if they are present in a class with the candidate or if they instructed the class that the candidate was present. Said "Registered" Master Guide CANNOT sign-off if they are not a witness to said line item.*

2. Authorized Master Guide List: *This list indicates individuals who have attended Master Guide Conventions and who are "Authorized" by the Master Guide Advisory to SIGN-OFF on the Master Guide Candidate Requirements (Yellow Sheet) as the candidates progress thru the line items, checks and reviews their portfolio, teaches, mentors and gives direction.*

For your convenience – CPR/1st Aid will be offered during this weekend for \$35 (10-20 people). If we have +21 people in the class the cost will be less. Please mark on the registration form appropriately.

Please Note - **Training Classes** that will be available during the weekend:

Shelter Management for Emergencies:

- With all the disasters we have been having, training will be given to be First Responders. After the training, and when there is a disaster that needs our assistance, we will be working in shelters and animal control. A special guest will be at the training to help us understand both areas. The guest will bring dogs and will show and teach us how to be certified animal handlers.

Oshkosh Camporee Security Training

- You will need to attend this training session if you are planning to assist me in the security area at Oshkosh. This will be a very important training class which you will be exposed to the rules and responsibilities of each Master Guide. I will also explain to you how the Conference will assist you once you arrive at Oshkosh with camping and food.
