

# SACS SUMMER/DAY CAMP 2018

## CAMPING ACROSS AMERICA!

Mission Statement: Children will experience hands-on, creative activities each day of camp. Campers will grow spiritually, mentally, and physically, while under the positive guidance of loving teacher/facilitator counselors.

Ages: 5 to 10 years old (current SACS students ages 3-12 may be accepted)

Grouping and Class Size:

Children will be put into classes based on age first, then on interest if we have enough campers. The expected adult-to-child ratio will be approximately 1:10. Maximum capacity: 28 campers.

Acceptance Policy:

Children who are current SACS students in regular standing are eligible for acceptance into the Camp. Those who are not current students will be required to present a letter of recommendation from an individual other than a family member, such as a church leader or a teacher. In order to maintain a safe, happy environment throughout the summer, children who are not willing and able to abide by the rules of the Camp will not be allowed to continue as participants in the Camp.

Weekly Dates:

Monday - Friday, May 29 to June 22, 2018 (payment due on May 18)

Monday – Friday, June 25 to July 20, 2018 (payment due on June 22)

BONUS WEEK: Monday-Friday, July 23-27, 2018 (payment due on July 20)

*Up to one week of vacation will be discounted if the vacation dates are indicated at the time payment is due.*

Hours:

7:30 - 9:00 Drop-off

9:00 - 3:00 Camp

3:00 - 5:30 Pick-up

First 8 hours/day included in camp fee.

After 8 hours, there will be a \$8/hour charge for care (minimum \$4).

Fees and Due Dates:

Registration fee: \$50/student (due by May 15); \$75 after May 15

Camp cost: \$425/student per 4-week period (\$450 if paid after deadline)

BONUS WEEK: \$105/student

No discount given for missed days.

A late fee will be charged for payments made after the due date.

Cost includes student insurance, art/craft supplies, and nutritious vegetarian snack.

Dress Code:

Campers should wear modest clothing that is comfortable for outdoor and indoor play. Tennis shoes or other closed-toe shoes must be worn due to sports activities. Unacceptable clothing includes: short-shorts, mini skirts, tank tops, bare midriff, and excessively tight or baggy garments. Logos or pictures should be appropriate for a Christian environment.

What to Bring:

Every day:

- ★ a healthy lunch
  - something from each food group:  
*fruit, vegetable, grain, protein* (if your protein is animal-based, please choose Kosher meats such as turkey, chicken, beef, etc.)
  - please avoid excessive sweets
- ★ water bottle

- ★ change of clothes
- ★ towel
- ★ water shoes
- ★ sunscreen
- ★ one-piece swimsuit or shirt/shorts

On Bike/Scooter days:

- ★ bike/scooter (may keep at school)
- ★ helmet
- ★ sunscreen

To keep at SACS all summer:

- ★ a large shirt to put on over clothes for art activities (maybe dad's old shirt)
- ★ *for children under 6:* a change of clothes for emergencies
