Why cry for a soul set free?**

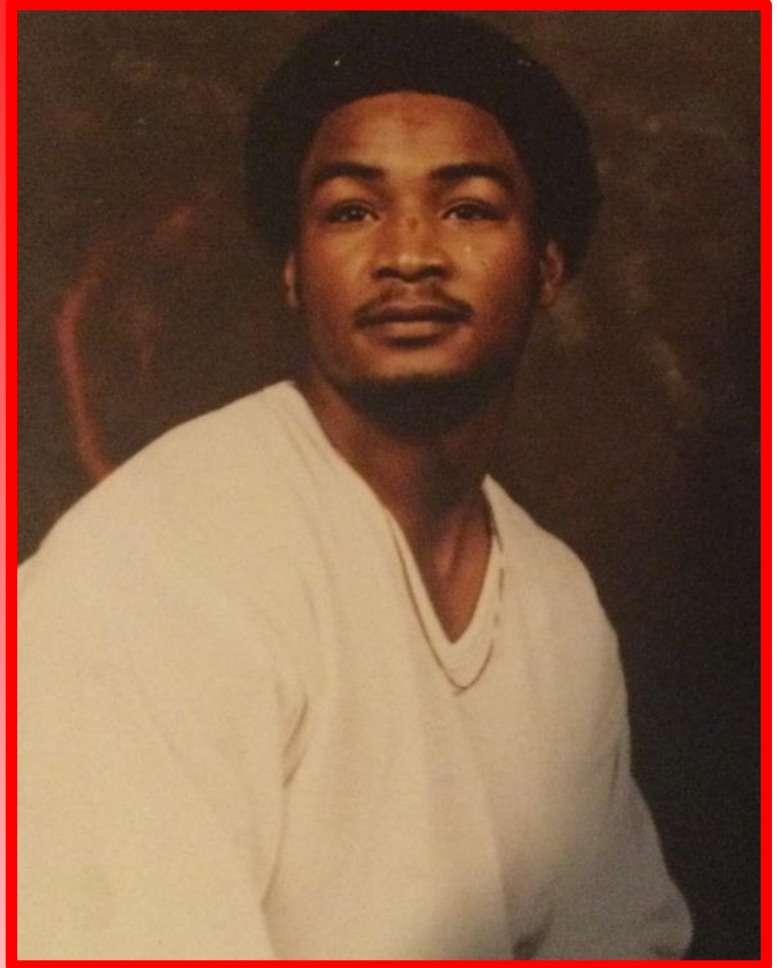
**Miss me a little-but not too long
