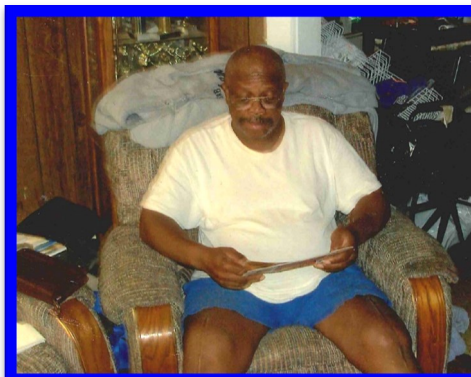
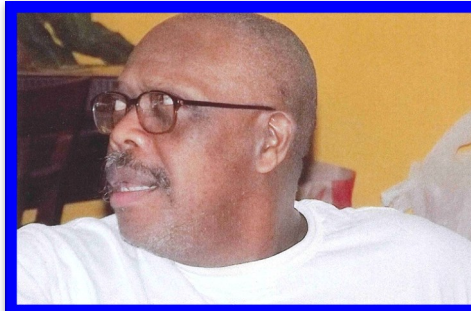
Obituary
