That nothing but our sadness

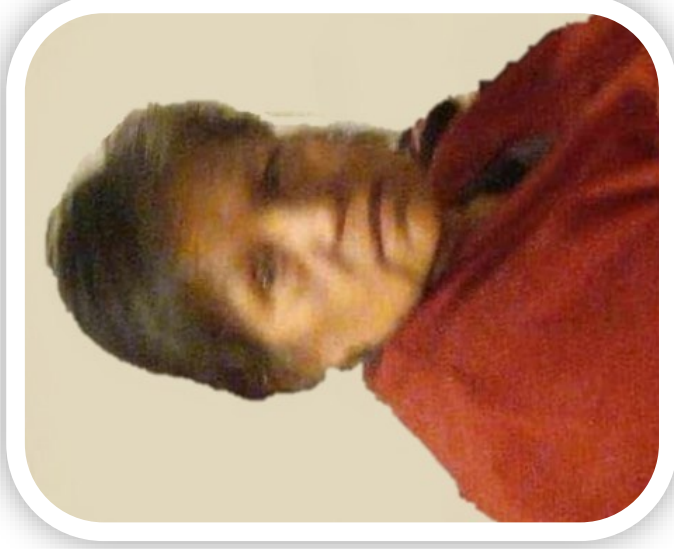
Can really pass away
