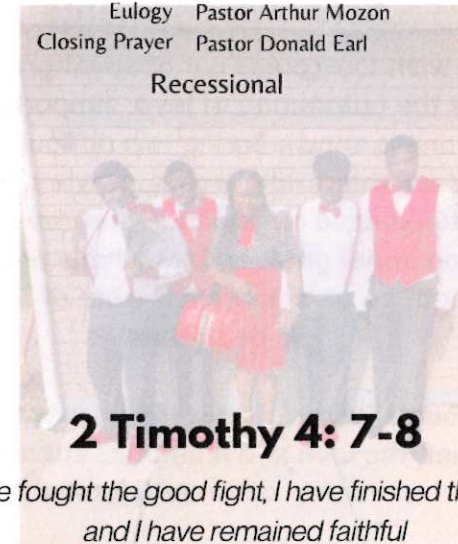
Tobios R. Earle's legacy of love and strength will continue to inspire all who were fortunate enough to walk alongside him in this life.
