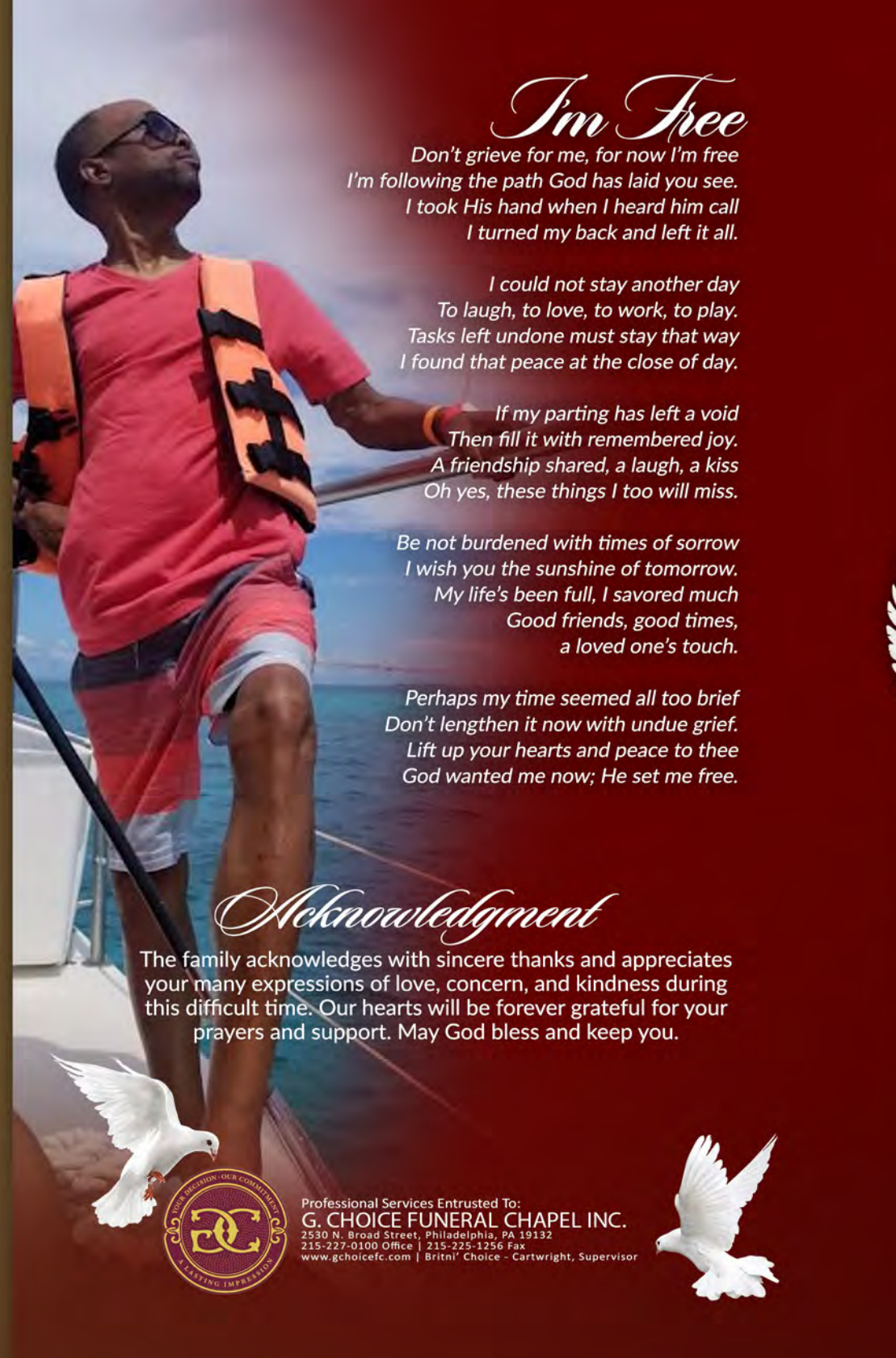

a loved one's touch.

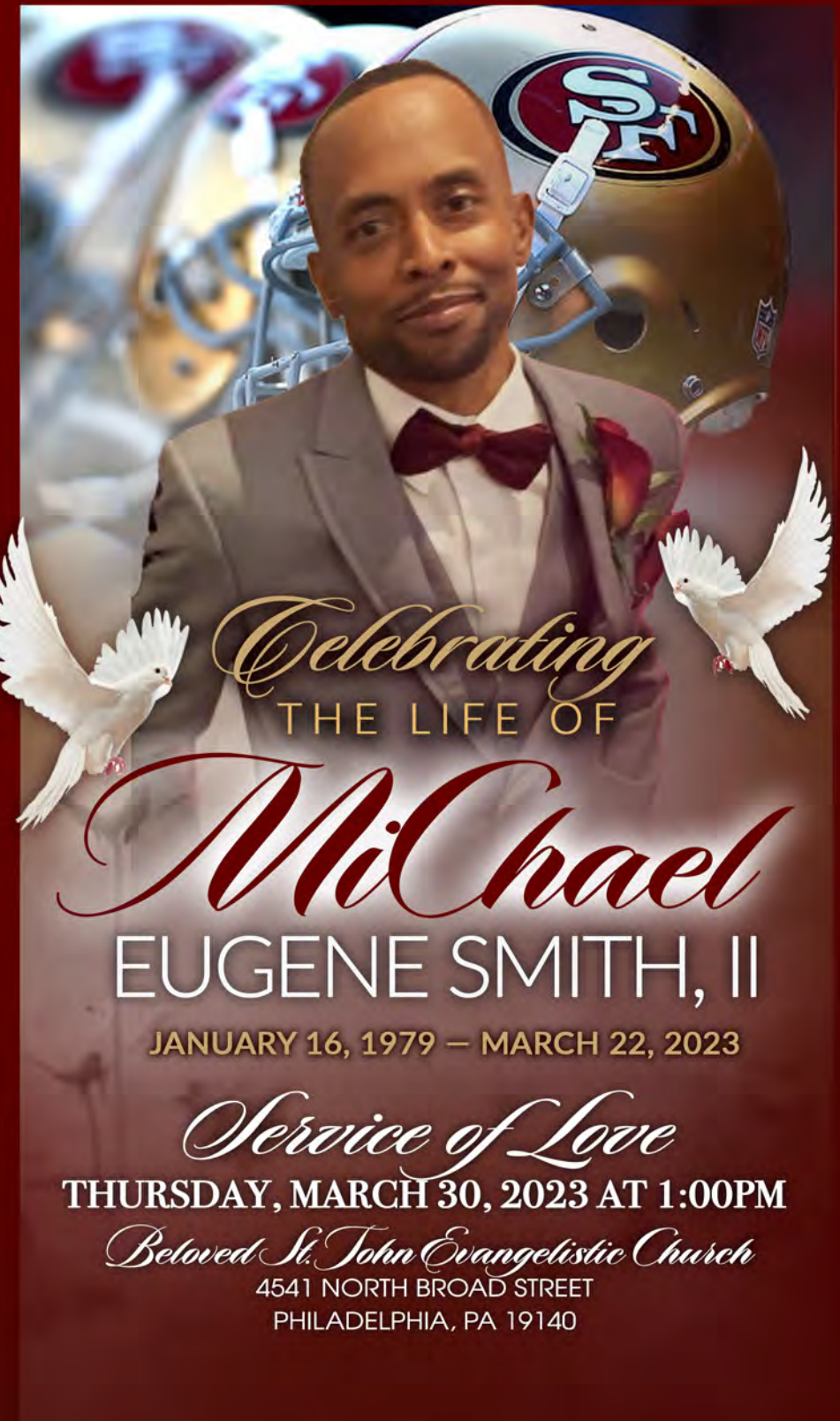
Perhaps my time seemed all too brief

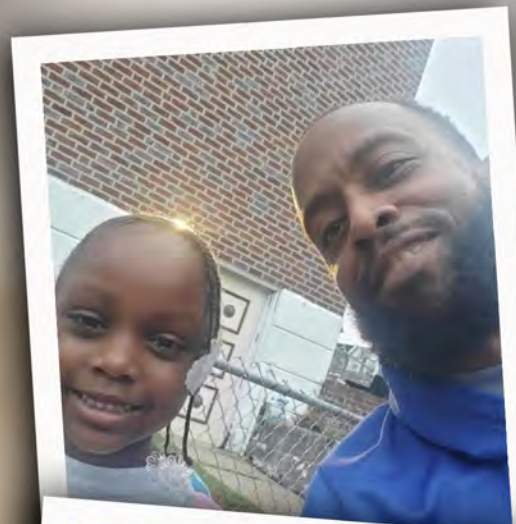
In 2022, MiChael became a member of Beloved Saint John Evangelistic Church.
