Before you walked into God's door!*

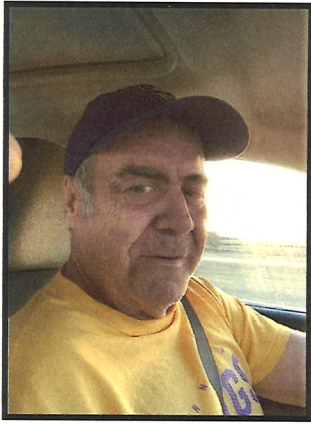
*It makes us feel better
