



34. **LL SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY IS LOOKING FOR PEOPLE FOR THEIR EXAMS:** "For our exam, we need someone who has a lot of tartar and calculus, and someone who needs a filling. People that go to the dentist every six months, or even yearly, likely don't have either of those. Those who may have not seen a dentist in 3 years or more are probably closer to who we're looking for. If you are someone who doesn't have access to a dentist, or maybe hasn't been in a little while, you can come to one of the screenings we are doing - **1/31, 2/7, 2/21 and 2/28 (Thursdays) from 5:15-6:30.** You can come in and we can assess if they would be a viable candidate. If you qualify and we end up using them in the exam, we will cover the cost of the filling or cleaning."

Reformation in the Church Library!



You may not have heard about it yet, but a reformation has taken place in our library. No, we didn't post 95 Theses on the door – but we have posted all of our books online! In doing so, we are following Martin Luther's commitment to accessibility. He translated the Bible from Latin to German – we have translated our paper catalog cards to bits and bytes so that you can access the information from wherever you might have internet access.

Here are the steps you need to take to gain this access at the Church Library:

- **Come into the library** either before or after services (9:00 to 9:30am and 10:15 to 10:45am each Sabbath) and **give us your name, e-mail address, and phone number.**
Note: If several people in your family share the same e-mail address, then you will also share your 'membership' in the library.
- Our computer program will send an e-mail to the address you give us, asking you to set up a user name and password so that you can then log on from home as a member.

Just by giving us your name and e-mail address you will immediately (the same day) be able to check out books. And once you go on line at <https://yucaipasda.librarika.com> and set up your user name and password, you will be able to log on as a member and search our catalog.

When you log on, you can click on the “Catalog Search” button. This allows you to search our entire catalog, or choose to narrow your search – for example, you can choose to search only books, or audio-visual items (such as CDs or DVDs). You can then choose to search by title, author, category, subject, etc. You can tell the computer to give you only a few answers. On the other hand, you can choose “Default” to be your guide. Then type in something in which you are interested, and the computer will show you a list of everything we have available.

For example, if you type in “Ellen G White” and click “search”, you will get 12 pages of books that we have either by or about her, including indexes to her works! Scroll through that list and find a book that interests you, then click on the title. Up will come a detailed description that includes the name of the author, the title of the book, the ‘tags’ that identify the types of information that the book provides, and a brief description of the contents of the book. The page will also show you related books that you might want to read. And last, but NOT least, you get the call number – the number on the spine of the book that allows you to find it on our shelf and check it out.

Once you have read the book, you can even go back to the same page and write a review! And, yes, if you don't return the book when due, our library program will send you a reminder that it's overdue. Those who do not have a computer or an email can still check out books the “old-fashioned way”.

We hope you will come in soon, sign up, and enjoy this **Library Reformation!**
