and saw you fade away.

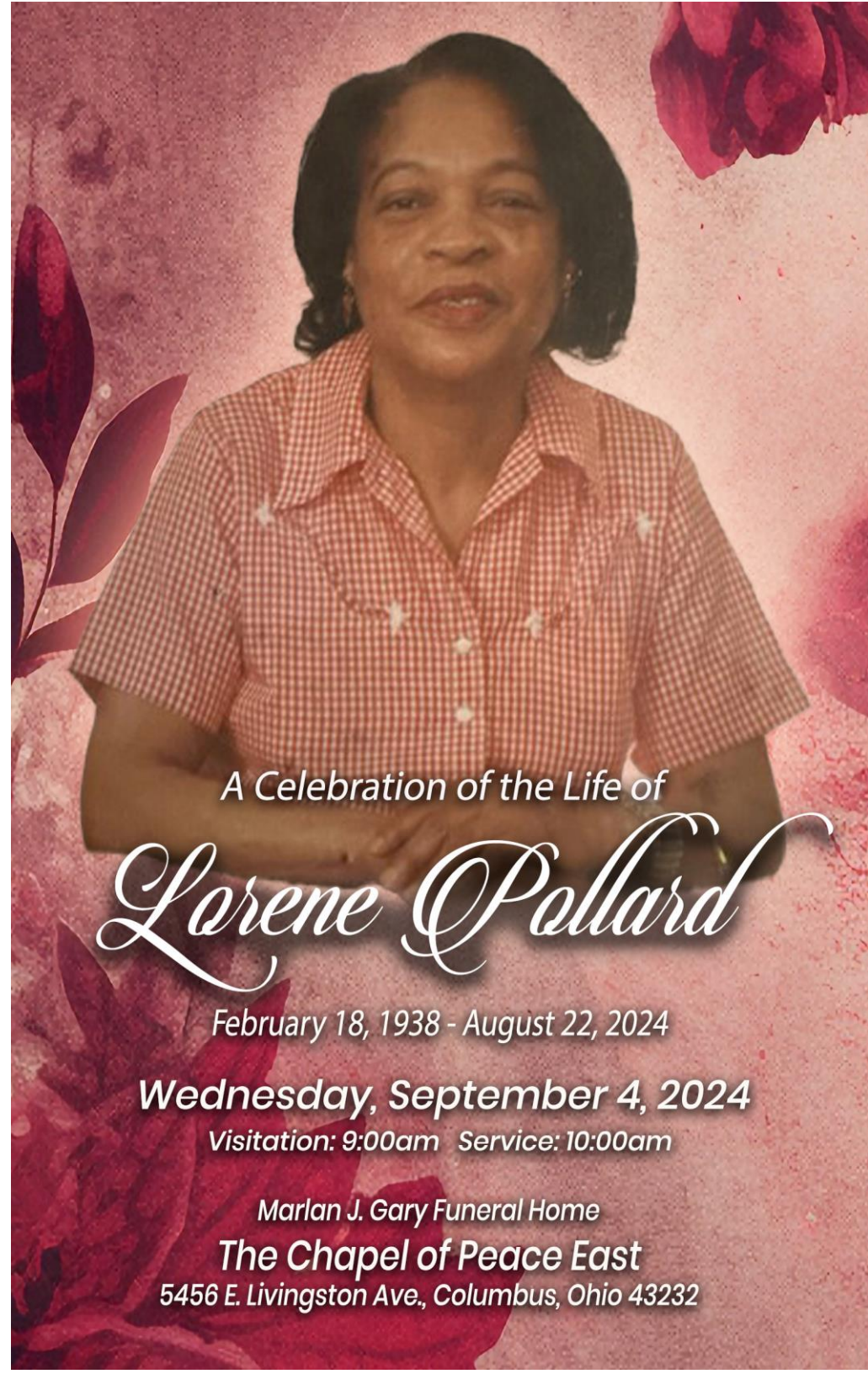
