A word from Mrs. Bryant

We've had a couple of close calls out in the parking lot during drop-off/pick-up. First and foremost, please drive slowly and keep your eyes peeled for kids. While we do our best to teach our students to stay within the crosswalks, they can occasionally dash across the parking lot where you wouldn't expect them to. Please be super vigilant.

Also, please don't park your car in the curb lane (the right lane) during times of drop-off/pick-up. Do not load and unload children from the through lane (left lane).

We really need more space in our parking lot and as a result, if you aren't planning on parking, you may need to go around the loop a few times before you can get into the right lane. Please be patient with our crossing guards and our students.
