For Today: If My People Pray

#1: God makes a deal. Think God won't make a deal? He does! In the middle of the night, He comes to a king with the best deal in the world for the people of the kingdom (2 Chronicles 7:14). Conditions: (1) Humble yourselves. (2) Seek my face in prayer. (3) Turn away from sin. Outcomes: (1) I will hear from Heaven. (2) I will forgive every sin. (3) I will restore your land and your life.

It doesn't get more clear than this. Or more simple. Or more powerful. Will you accept God's deal? For your soul. For your life. For our church. For our nation.

#2: Desperately ready. "Our church hasn't grown in years. What can we do?"

After decades of ministry and study, I can describe no fancy formula, powerful program, or magic methodology. But I have seen churches transformed, revived, multiplied, and grown. In every case, the miracle began when leaders and members brought their sins to Jesus, confessed their need, surrendered their resistance to change, and together claimed the promise of the Spirit through prayer.

If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him. (Luke 11:13).

Wait no longer. Even if you are one of only two or three in your congregation who feel desperately ready, you can act on God's promise.
