"O that there might be seen among our people a deep and thorough work of repentance and reformation! O that they would fall on the Rock and be broken! Let us crucify self that in our hearts may grow up a strong love for Christ and for one another. Let us bring into the daily experience the instruction contained in the thirteenth chapter of First Corinthians.
