I know because I've cried.*

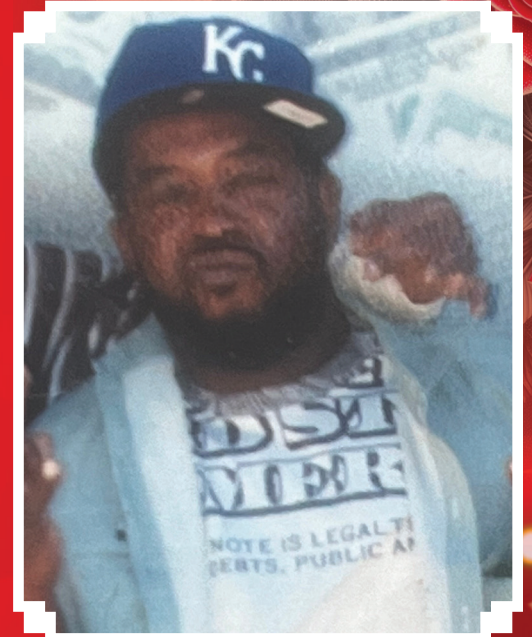
