

## Update on Idaho Conference Schools in Idaho

Friday, March 13, 2020

Idaho Governor Brad Little gave a press conference on the COVID 19 this morning. The important points for education are below:

There are still not diagnosed cases of COVID 19 in the state. But they feel there will be and most likely there will be infectious people around before anyone is diagnosed

At this point the Governor is **not** planning to have a state-wide closure of schools. Local school districts will make that call independently. Your school will go with the local school district. Please contact your local school district and ask them to keep your school informed of what the district is doing so you can be in harmony with them.

The focus for now is stringent school and personal hygiene and checking for students who are ill. Reminding parents not to bring ill students to school.

They did not give a length of time to keep the schools closed, but 14-21 days would be in the range considering what other states have done.

Okay, that is all for now. But things can change at any time. I will keep you up to date.
