'Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, persistent in prayer.' Romans 12:12

Over the last two weeks these words have really resonated with me after I fell and injured my right elbow, resulting in a trip to A & E and a number of hospital appointments.

This time has really made me think about the importance of patience in lots of different situations. When God says be patient in affliction He is reminding us that there will be seasons in life that we simply have to endure. Paul speaks of a season in his life where he was utterly unbearably crushed (2 Corinthians 1:8), this same affliction refers to financial burdens (Corinthians 8:13) and anxiety for a friend in trouble (Philippians 4:14). What does God require of us at such times? He does not say "Make sure you share your testimony and tell everybody you are doing fine." No, God says "Be patient! Hang in there. Hold steady. Stay the course."

We know how much God loves us because he has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with his love. We need to turn to the Holy Spirit and choose patience. Lord, we thank you for your grace which is limitless and for the hope you offer us. Lord, we pray for all those who are "hanging in there" right now, that they feel your presence and know your love.
