
The Heidelberg Catechism Lord's Day 1

Question 1. What is thy only comfort in life and death?

Answer: That I with body and soul, both in life and death, am not my own, but belong unto my faithful Savior Jesus Christ; who, with his precious blood, has fully satisfied for all my sins, and delivered me from all the power of the devil; and so preserves me that without the will of my heavenly Father, not a hair can fall from my head; yea, that all things must be subservient to my salvation, and therefore, by his Holy Spirit, He also assures me of eternal life, and makes me sincerely willing and ready, henceforth, to live unto him.

while they raised their 3 children. Geri did upholstery work for several years out of her home and later made a shop in the old chicken coop.

John and Geri were members of the Calvin Christian Reformed Church in Rock Valley where she was involved with the Faith Circle and the Rock Valley Christian School Ora et Labora. John died on May 9, 2008.

Those left to cherish her memory are her 3 children, Ted (Angela) Van Holland of Shawnee, Kansas, Donna (Daryl) Muilenburg of Maurice, Iowa, and Gaylon (Cindy) Van Holland of Rock Valley; 11 grandchildren; and 16 greatgrandchildren. She died on Monday, July 3, 2023 at Whispering Heights in Rock Valley the age of 91.

Geri is also survived by 2 brothers, Allan (Marlene) Vande Kamp of Rock Valley and Vernon (Leona) Vande Kamp of Orange City, Iowa; sister, Norma (Nelson) Nikkel of Pella, Iowa; 3 sisters-in-law, Harriet Vande Kamp of Sioux Center, Marla Vande Kamp of Orange City, and Darla Vander Wilt of Hospers, Iowa.
